1. **GraveStone1** – Lenora Marie Douchette Ariail, wife of Joseph Gabriel Antoine Remi “Pete” Ariail, from Canadian family line.
2. **GraveStone2** – Charles O. Turgeon, apparently connected with the Ariail family in the Alberta, Canada area.
3. **GraveStone3** – Stone for Joseph Gabriel Ariail and his wife Sophie Marie Bernard Ariail. Also contained on the stone is a picture of their son, Joseph Gabriel Antoine Remi “Pete” Ariail, husband of Lenora Marie Douchette.
4. **GraveStone4** – Stone for John Harvey Ariail and his wife Chloe Climelia Ives who moved from Connecticut to South Carolina about 1800. It is believed that their daughter Eliza Ariail is interred next to them in a vacant grave plot for the cemetery. This stone was funded and paid for by the Ariail Family Reunion Cemetery Project.
5. **GraveStone5** – Another view of graves listed in #4. These graves are in the Pickens Chapel Cemetery in Slabtown, Anderson County, South Carolina.
6. **GraveStone6** – Still another view of graves listed in #4. A later upgrade to these graves put coping and chipped stone on the graves.
7. **GraveStone7** – Still another view of the restoration project for the graves of John and Chloe Ariail.
8. **GraveStone8** – The top picture is of the stone for James Leland Ariail and his wife Ruth Hemphill Ariail in Toccoa, Georgia. The bottom image is that for the grave of Lucinda Ariail Curtis, daughter of John Harvey Ariail, III and Martha Catherine “Patty” Craig. Lucinda remembered and lived through the Civil War. She penned articles about what happened to them during this period in the family’s history.
9. **GraveStone9** – The top picture is stone for Edgar Duran Adams, husband of Effie Leo Ariail from Greenwood, South Carolina. The bottom stone is for Mary F. Caldwell Ariail, wife of Albert Harrison Ariail. She was the mother of Effie Leo Ariail.
10. **GraveStone10** – Top picture is Taylor family stone. Bottom stone is that of Sallie Cecelia Ariail Taylor, wife of Aaron Land Taylor, Sr.
11. **GraveStone 11** – Top picture is Henderson Family stone. Bottom stone is that for Mary Louise Ariail Grant Henderson who was daughter of Albert Harrison Ariail from South Carolina.
12. **GraveStone12** – Top picture is stone for Adams family into which Effie Leo Ariail married. Bottom stone is Alexander Stephens Lesley, husband of Sarah Jane Ariail.
13. **GraveStone13** – Top picture is stone for Sarah Jane “Sallie” Ariail Lesley in Canton, North Carolina. Bottom picture is of (left to right) Lorraine Anne Kimball Patterson and Effie Leo Ariail Adams. We were able to bring

Effie Leo Ariail Adams and Virginia Ariail Rouse together at the Ariail Reunion a few years ago for the first time. Both were in the 80's, 1st cousins, and had never met before they saw each other at the reunion.

14. **GraveStone14** – Top picture is of the Lesley Family Stone in North Carolina. Bottom is duplicate picture of Lorraine Anne Patterson and Effie Leo Ariail Adams.
15. **GraveStone15** – Top picture is of the grave plot for Clifford Daniel Ariail, Sr., son of James Daniel Ariail in Norcross, Georgia. Bottom picture is stone for Oscar Lee Ariail, husband of Frances Lucille Nicholson and son of John Milton Ariail from the Maysville, Georgia area.
16. **GraveStone16** – Top picture is stone of Caroline Emma Hodges Ariail, wife of Rev. James Warren Ariail in Sumter, South Carolina. Bottom stone is for Elizabeth Bland Ariail, wife of Robert Hodges Ariail in Sumter, South Carolina.
17. **GraveStone17** – Top picture is grave marker for Elizabeth Bland Ariail, wife of Robert Hodges Ariail. Bottom marker is for Clyde Milton Ariail, Sr., son of Warren Galloway Ariail, Sr., of James Island, South Carolina.
18. **GraveStone18** – Top picture is grave marker for Robert Hodges Ariail, son of Rev. James Warren Ariail. Bottom stone is the Baxter family marker in Black Swamp Cemetery, Garnett, South Carolina. This is for the family of Ruth Euzelia Ariail.
19. **GraveStone19** – Top picture is grave marker for Ruth Euzelia Ariail Baxter, daughter of Rev. William Hamilton Ariail and wife of Clifford Lawton Baxter. Bottom picture is marker for Clifford Lawton Baxter, Jr., son of Ruth Euzelia Ariail Baxter. Bio for Clifford Lawton Baxter, Jr.: Clifford Jr. is not married. He died at sea during WW II. A German submarine attacked the ship that Clifford was on in the vicinity of the Azores. It is not known if his remains were recovered. If not, then the marker in the Black Swamp Cemetery would be a memorial marker. There is no confirmation that the following article recovered pertains to Clifford Jr., however it is highly likely that it does: 2 Allied Ships Sunk by Subs: Navy disclosures yesterday of the loss of an American freighter in the North Atlantic and a British merchantman in the Caribbean--both last month--boosted to 459 the Associated Press count of Allied and neutral losses in the Western Atlantic since December 7. Two merchant sailors and two naval gunners were lost when Axis torpedoes blasted the medium-sized American craft, but forty-six survivors were rescued from rafts and a lifeboat by a British corvette and taken to a United Kingdom port. One of these men was hospitalized and the others have returned to the United States. All fifty-eight crewmen of the British vessel were rescued by a United States warship twenty minutes after their boat went down. Survivors said they did not see their attacker. (Note: It is believed that Clifford died on the American medium sized craft.)
20. **GraveStone20** – Top left picture is marker for Mary Elizabeth Baxter, daughter of Ruth Euzelia Ariail Baxter, top right is memorial marker for Clifford Lawton Baxter, Jr. Bottom left marker is for Frank Price Patten, husband of Carol J. Littlejohn, daughter of Frances Kathleen Ariail, bottom right marker is for Carol J. Littlejohn Patten, daughter of Frances Kathleen Ariail.
21. **GraveStone21** – Top picture is family stone for Benjamin Boyd Epton and his wife Nancy Pearl Ariail. Nancy is the daughter of John Alvin Ariail and Martha J. Field Ariail. Bottom is marker for John James Burnett, Jr. Mr. Burnett is stepson of Wilhelmina Ariail.
22. **GraveStone22** – Top left stone is marker for Geneva Elizabeth "Lizzie" Mauldin, daughter of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail. Top right marker is for Parthenia Aurelia Ariail Mauldin. Bottom marker is for Lowell T. Mauldin and his wife Amanda H. Davis Mauldin, who is son of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail Mauldin.
23. **GraveStone23** – Top is family plot and markers for the family of John Christopher Walker and Mollie Pearl Ariail Walker in Easley, South Carolina. Bottom is family plot for William McMurry Long and wife Cecile May Ariail Long. Cecile is daughter of Thomas Henry Ariail.
24. **GraveStone24** – Top picture is markers for Albert Jefferson Welborn and his wife Elizabeth Climelia Ariail. Elizabeth is the daughter of Luke Ives Ariail. Bottom is family stone in the Forest Cemetery, Gadsden, Alabama. Robert Franklin Ariail and his wife Emma Susan Barrett Ariail are buried here. Robert is the son of John Harvey Ariail, III, who died in the Civil War.
25. **GraveStone25** – Top picture contains markers for Robert Franklin Ariail and his wife Emma Susan Barrett Ariail. Bottom markers are, from left to right, for Emma Susan Barrett Ariail and her daughter Vivien Regina Ariail.

26. **GraveStone26** – Top picture, from left to right, is marker for Edna Earle Ariail, and Bertha Ardella Ariail Hightower. Both are daughter of Robert Franklin Ariail. Bottom are grave markers for Jesse Christian Mangels and wife Meryle Kincaid Ariail Mangels. Meryle is daughter of Robert Franklin Ariail.
27. **GraveStone27** – Top is picture of Hightower Family stone in Gadsden, Alabama. Bottom are grave markers for James Ida Hightower and his wife Bertha Ardella Ariail Hightower. Bertha is daughter or Robert Franklin Ariail.
28. **GraveStone28** – Top picture is family marker for Wadley, Blackman and Ariail plot. These are connected with Julius Fellows Ariail, I., who was son of Manna Rich Ariail. Bottom picture is that of Julius Fellows Ariail, I., (tall stone left rear) and Blackman Family. Julius was married to Jeannette Dent Blackman. The remains of Julius were later removed to another cemetery. See Ariail Family Cemetery Surveys document in family web site.
29. **GraveStone29** – Top picture is marker for the Ariail Plot in Pineville, Louisiana. Among those listed were John Murphy Ariail, Jannette Ariail, Jeannette Blackman Ariail, Julius Fellows Ariail, I., Julius Fellows Ariail, II., and Marie Louise Ariail. Bottom is picture of area where Manna Rich Ariail and Ellen Ariail are buried. See Ariail Family Cemetery Survey for complete list of those buried in this cemetery.
30. **GraveStone30** – Top picture is stone for Dr. James S. Fish, 2nd husband of Sarah Fellows who was wife of Manna Rich Ariail from Louisiana. Bottom stone is that of Catherine Bellamy Fellows who was the mother of Sarah Fellows.
31. **GraveStone31** – Top picture of original stone for Julius Fellows Ariail, I., so of Lt. Col. Manna Rich Ariail. Remains were removed to another cemetery where the remainder of the family is interred. See Ariail Family Cemetery Surveys for all listings for this family. Bottom stone is that of Sarah Fellows, wife of Manna Rich Ariail and Dr. James S. Fish.
32. **GraveStone32** – Top picture of grave plot and stones for Horace Wesley Ariail and William Martin Ariail who are both sons of James Horace Ariail, Sr. Bottom picture is the family plot for Ezekiel Bright Smith, his wife Lillian Modena Ariail and their daughter Lillian Smith at Enon Baptist Church, Easley, South Carolina.
33. **GraveStone33** – Top picture is of grave stone for Amos Reginald “Rex” Segars, son of Bernice Allene Ariail Segars from Washington, Georgia. Bottom stone is that of Barbara Jean Thompson, daughter of Barbara Janice Segars from the family line of Bernice Allene Ariail.
34. **GraveStone34** – Top picture is of stone for Albert Segars, husband of Bernice Allene Ariail who was daughter of John Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture is stone for Kathy Jo Anderson, daughter of Mary Gwynelle Segars from the family line of Bernice Allene Ariail Segars.
35. **GraveStone35** – Top picture is stone for grave plot in Sparta, Georgia for Henry Lester Ariail, Sr., son of Joseph Albert Ariail, Sr. His wife Rachel Josephine Stephens Ariail is buried next to him. Bottom picture is stone for family plot of John Claude Ariail and wife Mae Olive Logan Ariail in Wellington, Alabama.
36. **GraveStone36** – Top picture is individual grave marker for John Claude Ariail and bottom individual marker is for his wife Mae Olive Logan Ariail.
37. **GraveStone37** – Top picture is grave marker for Claude Samuel Fite and wife Mattie Lee Ariail in Jacksonville, Alabama. Bottom picture is for the grave site of Joseph Albert Ariail, Jr. He was the son of Joseph Albert Ariail, Sr. His widow Geneva Lucille Ritchie has since died and is interred next to him and the grave has been marked with a family stone.
38. **GraveStone38** – Top picture is marker for William Henry “Pop” Kinard and his wife Moida Lucile “Dearie” Ariail in Sanford, North Carolina. Bottom marker is for Charles Clifford Price and wife Lillian Frances Ariail in Randleman, North Carolina. Lillian is daughter of Albert Harrison Ariail.
39. **GraveStone39** – Top picture is grave marker for Leonard Clyde Ariail son of Albert Harrison Ariail in Greensboro, North Carolina. His wife Ruth Elizabeth Crowder Ariail is interred next to him. Bottom picture is marker for Zaida Lee Ariail Reece, daughter of Claude Harrison Ariail, Sr., and wife of Walter H. Reece.
40. **GraveStone40** – Top picture is grave marker for Walter H. Reece, husband of Zaida Lee Ariail. Bottom grave marker is for Claude Harrison Ariail and his wife Mildred Louise McElroy Ariail. Claude is the son of John Alvin Ariail.
41. **GraveStone41** – Top picture is grave marker for Vincent Dallas “Dad” Ariail and his wife Minnie Ethel Tanner Ariail. Vincent is son of Oscar Lee Ariail. Bottom picture is that of the Patterson Family Cemetery on Caudell

Road in Banks County, Georgia. The entire area was in need of much cleaning and repair. This picture was taken approximately 25 years ago and the cemetery is now cleaned each year by James Patterson and his wife Lorraine. James is the son of Lillie Blanche Ariail. This cemetery was originally located in the back yard of the Patterson Plantation and approximately 80 members of the family are interred here with only 3 readily identifiably.

42. **GraveStone42** – Top picture is another view of the Patterson Cemetery in Banks County, Georgia. Bottom picture is of Lorraine Patterson standing at the family grave plot of several members of the John Alvin Ariail family which include James Hamilton, Minnie, Nannie, Lillie Ariail and Valdee Styron, son of Lillie Ariail. This is located in the Rose Hill Cemetery in Piedmont, South Carolina. Later pictures will show this entire area being restored as part of the Ariail Family Restoration Project.
43. **GraveStone43** – Lorraine Patterson standing at the head of the unmarked graves of John Alvin Ariail and his 2nd wife Mary Ethel Brown Ariail. This entire family plot was upgraded under the Ariail Family Restoration Project. See later pictures. John Alvin Ariail is the son of Luke Ives Ariail.
44. **GraveStone44** – Top picture is grave marker for James Milton Ariail, Jr., son of Professor James Milton Ariail, Sr. Bottom picture is grave marker for Jane Elizabeth McBrayer Ariail, wife of James Milton Ariail, Jr. Professor James Milton Ariail, Sr., was Professor of English Literature at Columbia University and often attended the family reunions.
45. **GraveStone45** – Top picture is marker for Bonnie Lee Ariail, daughter of Maj. William Coke Ariail, Jr. from Spartanburg, South Carolina. Bottom picture is marker for Maj. William Coke Ariail, Jr., and his wife Christine Vestal. Do not as yet have documentation on her death or place of burial.
46. **GraveStone46** – Top picture is of grave marker for LeGrand Rouse and his wife Hilda Virginia Ariail Rouse from Spartanburg, South Carolina. Virginia is the daughter of the Rev. William Hamilton Ariail. Bottom picture is of marker for Charles Hamilton Sears, son of Wilhelmina Ariail. Charles was murdered and death was the result of a gunshot wound.
47. **GraveStone47** – Top picture is of grave marker for Wilhelmina Ariail Spears Burnett, daughter of the Rev. William Hamilton Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for Nancy Elizabeth Ozella Daniel Ariail, wife of The Rev. William Hamilton Ariail.
48. **GraveStone48** – Top picture is that of the family plot of Luke Ives Ariail and his wife Nancy Pearl Lesley Ariail in Westview Cemetery, Easley, South Carolina. This is one of the grave plots that was beautifully restored by the Ariail Family Reunion Association. When first found, the stones were removed from the grave sites, and as is readily visible, a roadway was across part of the two graves. The stones were reset in place, coping and chipped stone was placed on the graves, thus securing them for many years to come. The bottom picture is that of the stone for Nancy Pearl Lesley Ariail with the inscription “Mother of Methodist Ministers”.
49. **GraveStone49** – Top picture is that of the marker for Luke Ives Ariail, son of Esq. Ensign John Harvey Ariail, Sr., and his wife Chloe Climelia Ives. The inscription reads “Christian Gentleman”. The bottom picture is that of the ancient graveyard for the Richard Bellamy family who moved to the area well over 200 years ago. He is the ancient grandfather of Vastie Bellamy, wife of James Claude Ariail who was the ancestor of many of the Ariail family living in the Franklin/Banks county area.
50. **GraveStone50** – Both top and bottom pictures are of the ancient Richard Bellamy cemetery. the man standing at the grave site is Olen Ariail, son of James Claude Ariail.
51. **GraveStone51** – Both top and bottom pictures are additional views of the Richard Bellamy family cemetery.
52. **GraveStone52** – The top picture is of a marker identifying the location of the Richard Bellamy cemetery. The bottom photograph is that of Olen Ariail kneeling at the crumbled markers which is all that remains at the burial site of his ancient grandfather, John Bellamy.
53. **GraveStone53** – Another picture of Olen Ariail inspecting the crumbled grave markers at the John Bellamy Cemetery at the John Bellamy family cemetery. The cemetery is located near Indian Creek Baptist Church in Franklin County, Georgia.
54. **GraveStone54** – Top picture is of grave stone for V. Eleanor Lathem, daughter of Eliza Climelia Ariail. Bottom picture is of Eliza A. Lathem, daughter of Eliza Climelia Ariail and husband Lawrence Orr Lathem.

55. [GraveStone55](#) – Top picture is of the grave stone for Eliza Climelia Ariail, wife of Lawrence Orr Lathem, Eliza was daughter of John Harvey Ariail, III, and Martha Catherine “Patty” Craig. Bottom picture is of Silas Fennel Curtis, husband of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Lucinda was daughter of John Harvey Ariail, III.
56. [GraveStone56](#) – Top picture is the family grave plot for Dr. Cauthen Clyde Ariail, Sr. and his wife Dorothy Giles Ariail. Also interred in this plot is his 2nd wife, Mary Elizabeth Graydon Ariail. Cauthen is the son of the Rev. James Warren Ariail. Bottom picture is of the grave stone of Oscar Lee Ariail, son of John Milton Ariail.
57. [GraveStone57](#) – Top picture is the marker for Dr. William Thomas Ariail, Sr., son of DeWitt Ives Ariail from the Cornelia, Georgia area. The bottom picture is the marker for Cynthia Jean Martin, daughter of Eula Francine Ariail.
58. [GraveStone58](#) – Top picture is marker for James Verner Simmons, husband of Emily Imogene Ariail. Emily is the daughter of DeWitt Ives Ariail. Bottom family grave site is that of DeWitt Ives Ariail and his wife Eula Corrine Bellew Ariail. Dewitt is the son of James Leland Ariail.
59. [GraveStone59](#) – Top picture is the family plot for William Columbus Boling and his wife Georgie Correnna Ariail. Georgie is the daughter of James Leland Ariail. Bottom image is for the infant son of William Columbus Boling and Georgie Correnna Ariail Boling.
60. [GraveStone60](#) – Top picture is the family plot for Hubert David Roe and his wife Willie Hortense Ariail. Willie is the daughter of William Fields Ariail. Bottom picture is the marker for infant daughter of Hubert David Roe and Willie Hortense Ariail Roe.
61. [GraveStone61](#) – Top picture is the marker for the grave site of James Horace Ariail, Sr., and his wife Mildred Grace Cason Kuykendall Ariail. James is the son of William Martin Ariail. The bottom image is the marker for Jesse Thomas Ariail, Sr., son of James Hamilton Ariail.
62. [GraveStone62](#) – This is a picture of Jo-Ann Marjorie Cuvelier Johnson at the grave site of her mother, Daisie Ellen Margaret Ariail Cuvelier in Connecticut. As a young girl, Daisie went to Connecticut after the death of her father James Ives Ariail from TB in North Carolina. It took many years to find out what had happened to her after her father’s death.
63. [GraveStone63](#) – Picture of grave marker in Connecticut for Daisie Ellen Margaret Ariail, daughter of James Ives Ariail. Note how the family name is spelled. This member of the family was so far removed from her relatives that the correct spelling of the family name became unknown.
64. [GraveStone64](#) – Top picture is of the grave marker for Mary L. “Minnie” Rhoden Ariail, wife of James Hamilton Ariail in Piedmont, South Carolina. Bottom marker is for James Hamilton Ariail, son of John Alvin Ariail and husband of Minnie Rhoden Ariail. These stone were later cleaned and reset as one of the Ariail Family Reunion Cemetery Projects.
65. [GraveStone65](#) – Top picture is grave stone for Lillie Beatrice Ariail Styron Pryor, daughter of James Hamilton Ariail. The stone next to her marker is for Nolan Veldee Styron, her son. The bottom picture is the grave marker for Nannie Leona Ariail, daughter of James Hamilton Ariail and his wife Mary L. “Minnie” Rhoden.
66. [GraveStone66](#) – Top picture is grave marker for James Daniel Ariail, son of Ira Vandiver Ariail. Bottom marker is for Pearl Whitmore, wife of James Daniel Ariail.
67. [GraveStone67](#) – Top picture is grave marker for Garnette Lee Standridge, and wife Lettie Blanche Ariail. Lettie is daughter of James Leland Ariail and Lettie Meticia Duncan Ariail. Bottom marker is for Gordon Standridge, son of Lettie Blanche Ariail.
68. [GraveStone68](#) – Top picture is panoramic view of mausoleum where James D. Ariail is interred at Westview Abbey Cemetery in Atlanta, Georgia. Bottom marker is for Kate Archer Ariail Boggs Andrews. We have never been able to find out what happened to her 2nd husband, Otis M. Andrews. Her first husband Thomas Hamilton Boggs is interred at the Old Liberty Cemetery in Liberty, South Carolina. The Ariail Family Reunion Cemetery Restoration Committee placed a marker on his grave as part of the upgrade project a few years ago. Kate is the daughter of William Henry Harrison Ariail and Damie Acena Robinson Ariail. A picture of Damie is contained in the AriailPhoto section of the web site.
69. [GraveStone69](#) – Top marker is for Elizabeth Climelia Ariail, daughter of William Henry Harrison Ariail and wife of James Monroe Allison. Bottom marker is for James Monroe Allison.
70. [GraveStone70](#) – Top marker is for Dr. Tip Houston Mizell, husband of Annie Kathryn Allison from the Elizabeth Climelia Ariail family line. Middle picture is of marker for George Dewey Hill, husband of Mary

Irene Ariail, daughter of Ira Vandiver Ariail. Bottom marker is for grave of William Tyra Ariail, son of James Leland Ariail from the Nails Creek Community of Franklin County, Georgia.

71. **GraveStone71** – Top marker is grave of Mary C. “Mamie” Wiley Ariail, wife of William Tyra Ariail located in the Magnolia Cemetery, Atlanta, Georgia. Middle marker is for George William Ariail and his wife Evelyn Machala Moore Ariail. George William Ariail is the son of William Tyra Ariail and grave is in Magnolia Cemetery, Atlanta, Georgia. Bottom marker is for William Tyra Ariail, son of James Leland Ariail.
72. **GraveStone72** – Top image is grave marker for Mary C. “Mamie” Wiley Ariail, wife of William Tyra Ariail. Middle picture is of owner of Magnolia Cemetery standing at the grave sites of the Ariail family buried there. He was nice enough to show us where they were buried because grass had overgrown all the markers. Bottom picture is grave marker of Cora Lee Ariail, daughter of John Alvin Ariail and wife of Walter Watson Hamilton at Hollywood Cemetery in Gastonia, North Carolina.
73. **GraveStone73** – Top image is marker for Walter Watson Hamilton, husband of Cora Lee Ariail. Middle picture is that of the marker for Charles Edward Ariail, son of Albert Harrison Ariail. Bottom image is the marker for Ila Augusta “Bitsy” Lingle Ariail, wife of Charles Edward Ariail.
74. **GraveStone74** – Top family grave stone is for the family of Robert Truesdale Ariail at the Forest Lawn Cemetery in Charlotte, North Carolina. Middle marker is for Robert Truesdale Ariail, son of William Coke Ariail, Sr. Bottom image is for the marker of Elizabeth Scott Diman Ariail, wife of Robert Truesdale Ariail.
75. **GraveStone75** – Top picture is grave marker for Fontis Clyde Allen, III, son of Marjorie Elizabeth Ariail. Middle marker is for William Coke Ariail, son of Rev. William Hamilton Ariail and Hattie Elizabeth Yeargin. Bottom marker is for Amaryllis Pride Sitgreaves Ariail, wife of William Coke Ariail, Sr.
76. **GraveStone76** – Top marker is a duplicate picture for the marker of Fontis Clyde Allen, III, son of Marjorie Elizabeth Ariail. Middle family plot is for Rev. Robert Sidney Truesdale, husband of Bessie Ariail. Bottom image is marker for Bessie Ariail, daughter of Rev. William Hamilton Ariail and wife of Rev. Robert Sidney Truesdale.
77. **GraveStone77** – Top picture is of marker for Rev. Robert Sidney Truesdale, husband of Bessie Ariail. Bottom blurred image is of the marker for Prof. James Nardin Truesdale, son of Rev. Robert Sidney Truesdale. Adelaide Bailey Truesdale, wife of Prof. James Nardin Truesdale is also listed on this marker.
78. **GraveStone78** – The top and bottom images are pictures of the area around Shuttle Meadow Mountain in Southington, Connecticut. These pictures were taken when researching the area where John and Hannah Ariail might be buried. After all research was completed, it was determined that they are interred in the South End Cemetery, Southington, Connecticut. The curators of this cemetery also think they are interred there. See additional pictures in this document for authentication.
79. **GraveStone79** – Additional pictures taken of the area where John and Hannah lived during the 1775-1800 period in Southington, Connecticut.
80. **GraveStone80** – Still more pictures taken of the general area where John and Hannah Ariail lived in the Southington, Connecticut area. Enjoy the scenery without the expense of going there.
81. **GraveStone81** – Yet one more picture of the beautiful lake near where John and Hannah Ariail lived. Bottom picture is the Bellamy Cemetery in Bethlehem, Connecticut. Luke Ariail, son of John and Hannah Ariail lived in Bethlehem, died there, and is buried in this cemetery along with other family members. Later documents will show where the Ariail Family Reunion Cemetery Committee placed stones on unmarked graves in this cemetery.
82. **GraveStone82** – Top picture is of the grave of Lucy Marie Dunham Lewis, daughter of Lucy Ariail. She most likely died as a result of complications from child birth. Her infant son, Charles Lewis, is buried next to her in the cemetery. Bottom picture is of Dea. Oliver Lewis, husband of Lucy Marie Dunham. Oliver was married a 2nd time to Emma Lyman after the death of Lucy Marie Dunham.
83. **GraveStone83** – Top image is picture of Lorraine Anne Kimball Patterson standing by the stone of Roxanna Dunham Ashley, daughter of Lucy Ariail. We have never been able to determine what happened to her husband Elijah Ashley or whether he was the mother to any children. Bottom image is picture of stone for Samuel Dunham, husband of Lucy Ariail. He died in 1811 and his wife Lucy Ariail was twice more married, passing in 1867.

84. **GraveStone84** – Dunham Family Plot in the Oak Hill Cemetery, Southington, Connecticut. Several relatives of Lucy Ariail are buried here. Bottom family plot is the Kimball/McNeil plot in Milo, Maine. The parents and several family members of Lorraine Anne Kimball Patterson, wife of James W. Patterson (family historian), are interred here.
85. **GraveStone85** – Top picture, entire front row of stones are members of Lorraine Anne Kimball Patterson's family who are interred in the cemetery in Milo, Maine. Most carried the family name of Perrigo. Bottom picture is grave site for Annie Blanche Ariail, daughter of Joseph Albert Ariail, Sr.
86. **GraveStone86** – Top picture is the family plot for David Daniel Mosely, Jr. and his wife Hattie Revelle Ariail. Hattie is the daughter of Omer Manson Ariail. Bottom picture is that of the John Bellamy family cemetery. It is in a cow pasture just a short distance from the back of Indian Creek Baptist Church in Franklin County, Georgia.
87. **GraveStone87** – Top picture is that of Olen Thomas Ariail standing between the grave markers of his ancient grandfather and grandmother, Pleasant J. Bellamy and his wife Sarah Johnston Chatham Bellamy at Indian Creek Baptist Church Cemetery, Carnesville, Georgia. Bottom image is that of Fleming Family plot. Buried there are George Welborn Fleming and his wife Lucy Tryphosa Ariail. Lucy is the daughter of James Leland Ariail and Lettie Meticia Duncan.
88. **GraveStone88** – Top picture is another view of John Bellamy family burial plot. These are ancestors of the Ariail family which lived near Nails Creek Baptist Church where the reunion is held annually. Bottom image is that of the marker for Thelma Elizabeth Ariail, daughter of Joseph Albert Ariail, Sr. Her husband was William Hal Ellison, Sr.
89. **GraveStone89** – Top picture is of Carmel Presbyterian Church near Easley, South Carolina. Climelia Abigail Ariail, her husband and several of her descendants are buried here in the cemetery. Bottom picture is of the grave site of Luke Ives Ariail and his wife Nancy Pearl Lesley. Lorraine Anne Patterson and Lt.Col. Doyce Ariail are standing at the stones. You will note that the graves are in the middle of one of the cemetery driveways. The Reunion Association Committee took this on as a project and the stones were reset, cleaned, coping put around the graves, plastic laid upon the ground with chipped stones placed on the graves. The city will no longer be able to run across these graves with the vehicles and cemetery equipment.
90. **GraveStone90** – Top is same picture as #89, but with James W. Patterson (cemetery chairman) standing at the headstone for one of the graves. Bottom headstone is that of Nancy Pearl Lesley, wife of Luke Ives Ariail.
91. **GraveStone91** – Top picture is that of the headstone for Nancy Pearl Lesley, wife of Luke Ives Ariail. Bottom picture is that of James Patterson stand at the marker for Climelia Abigail Ariail, wife of Lemuel Greenlee Hamilton. Climelia is the daughter of John Harvey Ariail and his wife Chloe Climelia Ives Ariail. This entire family plot was one which the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee took as a project and cleaned, restored and replaced all the stones that were in need of care.
92. **GraveStone92** – Left picture is that of the headstone for Lemuel Greenlee Hamilton, husband of Climelia Abigail Ariail. Lemuel is descended from Royalty in Europe. Right image is of LtCol. Doyce Ariail, President of the Ariail Reunion Association, standing at the marker for the graves of Lemuel Greenlee Hamilton and his wife Climelia Abigail Ariail.
93. **GraveStone93** – Top picture is another view of the stone for Lemuel Greenlee Hamilton and his wife Climelia Abigail Ariail. Bottom view is of the Church identification marker and the cemetery in the background.
94. **GraveStone94** – Top picture is a beautiful marker for the Rev. John L. Kennedy. This marker is near the wall of the Carmel Presbyterian Church. He is the pastor who married William Harrison Ariail and Mary Adelaide Barr. This couple moved from South Carolina to Georgia in the 1850's and have left a vast amount of descendants. Bottom picture is that of James Patterson pointing to the just discovered graves of John Harvey Ariail and Chloe Climelia Ives Ariail. These graves have been since restored and are being looked after on a regular basis to ensure their integrity.
95. **GraveStone95** – Top picture is of Lorraine Ann Patterson kneeling at the grave site of Chloe Climelia Ives Ariail, wife of John Harvey Ariail at the Old Pickens Chapel Cemetery in Slabtown, South Carolina. Bottom picture is that of (left to right) Kermit, Felton and Olen Ariail (brothers) and sons of James Claude Ariail at

the graves of John Harvey Ariail and Chloe Climelia Ives. What a joyous find was this for the entire family and many of them have since visited these graves of people born as early as 1775. The family bible of this ancient family is still intact and in the possession of the Family Historian and will be passed down through the family. Keith Ariail, current President of the Ariail Reunion Association, has been designated as protector of this document with the passing of the current historian.

96. **GraveStone96** – Top picture is that of the family plot of Benjamin Claude Ariail and his wife Eurella Brown. Claude was the son of John Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture marks the Rockville Center. When John Harvey Ariail first came to South Carolina, he was working for a firm from Petersburg, Virginia named Harts and Wright. John Harvey Ariail was buying land for them in a new town called Rockville, South Carolina. This entire area is now known as Easley, South Carolina. John Harvey Ariail got into somewhat of a problem with the authorities concerning some of the work he was doing and went back to Connecticut. He there married and a few years later came back to the place he knew in South Carolina and lived the rest of his life there. His eldest son was born in Connecticut with the remainder of the family being born in South Carolina.
97. **GraveStone97** – Top picture is of the family plot of Asa Martin Neal and his wife Elsie Lee Ariail, Elsie is the daughter of Robert Lee Ariail. Bottom picture is that of the stone Wayne Watson Gillespie and his wife Lizzie C. Ariail. Lizzie is the daughter of Ira Vandiver Ariail.
98. **GraveStone98** – Top picture is that of the family plot for James D. Higginbotham and his wife Wilda Ariail. Wilda is the daughter of Robert Lee Ariail. Bottom picture is that of the family plot for Robert Lee Ariail, his wife Fannie Lee Varner Ariail, daughter Fannie Lee Ariail and 2nd wife Ruby Iona Mize Ariail. Robert Lee Ariail is the son of James Leland Ariail.
99. **GraveStone99** – Top picture is of the family plot of John Milton Ariail, his wife Narcissa E. “Northy” Hendricks Ariail and his son William Harrison Ariail. This entire family plot has been beautifully repaired and cleaned under the direction of the Ariail Cemetery Committee. Most of the funds for this project were donated by David Ariail in North Carolina and Peggy Marie Ariail Bridges of North Carolina. The Family Plot is in the Sunrise Cemetery, Maysville, Georgia. John Milton Ariail fought in the Civil War at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania as a Confederate soldier. His cousin, Phineas Dunham, from the Minnesota Regiment also fought against John in this battle. John Milton Ariail and his cousin were both wounded. John Milton Ariail healed and returned home but unfortunately, Phineas Dunham died from this wound and is interred in the Minnesota Regiment cemetery at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. Bottom picture is that of the family plot for Omer Gilbert Ariail and his wife Annie Marion Payne Ariail. Omer is the son of Omer Manson Ariail.
100. **GraveStone100** – Top picture is family plot for Joseph Albert Ariail, Sr. and his wife Orpha Elizabeth “Lizzie” Garrison Ariail. Joseph Albert Ariail is the son of James Leland Ariail. Bottom picture is that of plot for Omer Manson Ariail and his wife Hattie Elizabeth Strange Ariail. Omer Manson Ariail is the son of James Leland Ariail.
101. **GraveStone101** – Top picture is that of the Ariail Grave Plots at Sunrise Cemetery in Maysville, Georgia. Bottom picture is a duplicate of Kermit, Felton and Olen Ariail visiting the graves of their ancient grandparents at Pickens Chapel, Slabtown, South Carolina. These graves were beautifully restored by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee.
102. **GraveStone102** – These pictures are a closer look at the stones of Luke Ives Ariail and his wife Nancy Pearl Lesley before the restoration project by the Ariail Cemetery Committee. The top picture is of the stone of Nancy Pearl Lesley Ariail and the bottom stone is for Luke Ives Ariail. The town of Easley, South Carolina would never give us permission to perform this work as the graves were in the middle of a cemetery driveway, so we eventually decided to perform the work without permission. Luke was a very prominent citizen of the town and entire area. We never received any adverse feedback from the town for our work.
103. **GraveStone103** – Picture of grave marker for Mary Ellis Oryall, wife of Floyd Alton Oryall, from the Canadian family line. Floyd was the son of Viola Mae Oryall who was descended from Michel Ariail. Michel Ariail was born just a few days before his father Jean Baptiste Mathias Ariail left Canada for Massachusetts. See other parts of the Family Web Site for details as to why he may have left his family in Canada and go to Massachusetts.
104. **GraveStone104** –Picture of the cemetery where 2nd Lt. Henry Thomas Gillespie is buried. Henry was the son of Mary Climelia Ariail and daughter of William Harrison Ariail/Mary Adelaide Barr. See following Bio: 2nd

Lt., 168th Infantry, 42nd Infantry Division. Killed Argonne Forest, France. Buried in France. Henry was of medium height, medium build with light brown hair and light brown eyes. Buried in the Meuse-Argonne American Cemetery, Romange-sous-Montfaucon, Meuse, France. Buried in Plot F, Row 20, Grave 22.

105. **GraveStone105** – Top picture is that of the Red River area in Alexandria, Louisiana near the place where Manna Rich Ariail and his family resided. Manna is buried in Louisiana but members of his family are interred in a cemetery in this area. We were informed by the officials in the area that a flood destroyed many of the graves in the cemetery and some of those may have been members of Manna's family as we have not been able to find some of the graves. Bottom picture is of the Walker family plot in Alabama where Antoinette Walker Ariail, daughter of Dr. Preston Lucas Walker and wife of Henry Ellis Ariail, Sr., is buried. Although some believe that Henry Ellis Ariail, Sr., was not married to this woman, it is very likely that he was. Dr. Walker sent Henry to Auburn University to study to be a druggist and Henry later owned his own drug store near Birmingham, Alabama. Dr. Walker was also a druggist, so all the dots match and we believe we are correct in our assessment. We have been told that Henry was a very distinguished individual and that in the latter stages of life, would sit and talk with people dressed with his bow tie. His daughter, Anne Stuart Ariail became Miss Alabama and runner-up to Miss America. I have personally met Anne and she is a fascinating individual to meet and know.
106. **GraveStone106** – Top picture is Elizabeth Maud "Bessie" Ariail, wife of Tom A. Jones. and Mabel A. Ariail, wife of Thomas Lee Smith. We do not know what happened to Tom A. Jones. Thomas Lee Smith died in Calhoun, Alabama. Both ladies probably did not live with their husband and when they died, were buried next to each other, with a common marker in Alabama. They were the daughters of Robert Franklin Ariail and his wife Emma Susan Barrett. Bottom Picture is that of Aunt Jemima Pickens, housekeeper to Gen. Pickens of South Carolina. She lived to be 105 years of age. The Anderson County Cemetery Records state that she is the original Aunt Jemima. She is buried near the place where John and Chloe Ariail are interred in the historic Pickens Cemetery in Anderson County, South Carolina.
107. **GraveStone107** – Left side picture is that of the stone of Arba Merriam, a cousin of Chloe Climelia Ives Ariail, wife of John Harvey Ariail. He, according to best assessment of records recovered, probably came down from Connecticut with John and Chloe Ariail and lived in the area for the remainder of his life. He is buried in the Historic Pickens Cemetery near John and Chloe. Right side picture is that of Samuel Barr, father of Mary Adelaida Barr who married William Harrison Ariail, son of John and Chloe Ives Ariail. He also is buried close to John and Chloe Ariail.
108. **GraveStone108** – Left picture is marker for the grave of Mary Warnock Barr, mother of Mary Adelaide Barr who was wife of William Harrison Ariail. It is in the Historic Pickens Chapel Cemetery and has since been replaced by a new marker. The right picture is of a stone called the Westview Marker. It identifies graves in the cemetery that were marked by field stones. This was one of the pieces of evidence that we used to locate the grave of John and Chloe Ariail.
109. **GraveStone109** – Top picture is of the marker for Reginald Stanley Ariail, infant son of the Rev. William Hamilton Ariail. The entire grave site has been upgraded and a new stone placed by the Ariail Family Reunion Cemetery Committee. The bottom picture is of Kings Chapel Methodist Church where the Rev. William Hamilton Ariail was pastor when his son died.
110. **GraveStone110** – Left picture is marker for Davies Marvin Ariail, son of The Rev. William Hamilton Ariail. The right side marker is for Hattie Elizabeth Yeargin, wife of the Rev. William Hamilton Ariail and mother of Davies Marvin Ariail.
111. **GraveStone111** – Picture of Dials Methodist Church where Davies Marvin Ariail and his mother Hattie Elizabeth Yeargin Ariail are buried.
112. **GraveStone112** – Top picture is of the family plot of Warren Galloway Ariail, Sr. He is the son of the Rev. James Warren Ariail. His wife Essie Bright Smith Ariail and son Clyde Milton Ariail are also marked here, however, his son is buried on James Island, South Carolina. The bottom picture is that of the grave marker for the Rev. William Hamilton Ariail in Florence, South Carolina. His son Robert "Bobby" Francis Kinard was interred there in an unmarked grave. The Ariail Family Reunion Cemetery Committee has since placed a perpetual marker on his grave site as one of our yearly projects. See Cemetery Committee annual reports for more information on this grave project.

- 113. GraveStone113** – The top picture is of the grave of Dr. Robert Hodges Ariail, son of the Rev. James Warren Ariail. Bottom picture is that of Minnie Philson Raye Ariail Armstrong, wife of Dr. Robert Hodges Ariail.
- 114. GraveStone114** – Top picture is another view of the graves of Dr. Robert Hodges Ariail and his wife Minnie Philson Raye Ariail Armstrong. Bottom picture is that of Lorraine Anne Patterson standing at the head of the gravestone of William “Little Willie” Ariail, son of the Rev. James Warren Ariail. At the request of William Smith Ariail, the Cemetery Committee put a new marker on this grave and beautifully improved its surroundings.
- 115. GraveStone115** – Top picture is of the grave plot for Robert Lee Ariail, Sr., and his wife Margaret Susan Morris in Willington, South Carolina. Robert Lee Ariail is the son of Albert Harrison Ariail, The bottom picture is the marker for Foster Morris Ariail, son of Robert Lee Ariail.
- 116. GraveStone116** – Top picture is panoramic view of the Cemetery at Troy, South Carolina where several of the Ariail family are interred. Pictures of individual graves will be in other photographs. Bottom beautiful stone is that for the Rev. James Warren Ariail and his wife Caroline Emma Hodges Ariail in the Elmwood Cemetery in Columbia, South Carolina. Rev. James Warren Ariail is the son of Luke Ives Ariail.
- 117. GraveStone117** – Left picture is that of the grave marker for Professor James Milton Ariail, Sr., Professor of English at Columbia College for 60 years. He and his wife attended the Ariail Reunion on a regular basis while he was still living. It is rumored that someone asked his wife “Are you ever jealous of your husband because he is such a handsome gentleman?” It is said that her response was something to the effect “If no other woman wanted him, I probably wouldn’t either.” He was the son of the Rev. James Warren Ariail. Right picture is the grave marker for Belvadera McCall Haynsworth Ariail, wife of Prof. James Milton Ariail, Sr. She was a member of the D.A.R, U.D.C. and First Families of South Carolina. Also she was honored by Columbia College in 1980.
- 118. GraveStone118** – Top picture is the grave marker for Vertie Green Ariail, 1st wife of Professor James Milton Ariail, Sr. Bottom picture is family plot for Albert Herman Ariail and his wife Willie Irene Shealy Ariail. Albert Herman Ariail is the son of Albert Harrison Ariail. Cemetery in Columbia, South Carolina.
- 119. GraveStone119** – Top picture is the family grave plot for Thomas Muldrow Ariail, Sr., and his wife Edna Maie Johnston Ariail. Thomas Muldrow Ariail, Sr., is the son of Prof. James Milton Ariail, Sr. Bottom picture is that of Emma Ariail Ellis Smith, daughter of the Rev. James Warren Ariail. We yet have no information on her two husbands; however, Ormand Smith is listed as being buried in the same cemetery as she.
- 120. GraveStone120** – Top picture is that of Elizabeth Steadman Ariail, wife of Cauthen Clyde Ariail, Jr. Bottom picture is that of Robert Lee Ariail, Jr., son of Robert Lee Ariail, Sr. Buried in Lexington, South Carolina.
- 121. GraveStone121** – Top picture is of the family plot for William Hendy Ritter and his wife Lallah Sally Carrie Ariail. Lallah is the daughter of the Rev. James Warren Ariail. Bottom picture is that of the markers for Herman Harrison Ariail and his 2nd wife Margaret Quick Ariail. Herman Harrison Ariail is the son of Albert Herman Ariail.
- 122. GraveStone122** – Top picture is of the family plot for Rufus Benjamin James and wife Denise Ethel Ariail. Denise Ethel Ariail is the daughter of Albert Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture is of the plot of Cpl. Audley H. Ward and his wife Nell Lucille Ariail. Nell is the daughter of the Rev. James Warren Ariail.
- 123. GraveStone123** – Top picture is of marker for Joseph Andrew McNeill, son of Ila Eulela Ariail. His wife Estelle Bannister is now deceased and probably buried next to him. Bottom picture is that of Andrew Walker McNeill and his wife Ila Eulela Ariail. Ila is the daughter of John Alvin Ariail.
- 124. GraveStone124** – Top picture is of the family plot for Alvin Franklin Ariail and his wife Hettie Lou Green Ariail. Alvin Franklin Ariail is the son of James Hamilton Ariail. Bottom picture is of Harvey Oscar Ariail, son of Albert Harrison Ariail. Bio. At the time of his death, he ran a filling station in Abbeville, South Carolina. He tragically died in a house fire. He enjoyed reading and apparently fell asleep one night while reading. His heating stove malfunctioned and burned the house. No family member was allowed to view his remains because he was so extensively burned.
- 125. GraveStone125** – Top picture is of the marker for Cpl. Audley H. Ward, husband of Nell Lucille Ariail. Bottom marker is of Nell Lucille Ariail, daughter of the Rev. James Warren Ariail.
- 126. GraveStone126** – Top picture is of the marker for James Ives Ariail, son of Albert Harrison Ariail. James died of TB shortly after a failed attempt to find the remains of his son Albert M. Ariail who died by drowning in

the Cooper River in Charlestown, South Carolina. See Cemetery Surveys for the exact location of the burial of Albert M. Ariail after his remains were recovered. James Ives Ariail was twice married, 1st to Cornelia E. DuBose Ariail who passed away in Lexington, South Carolina. Her gravesite has never been determined with the possibility that her remains are beneath the large lake that was later constructed in that area. His 2nd wife survived him and her location has never been determined. Bottom picture is that of Henry Wallace Ariail, son of Albert Harrison Ariail. He was married but died young and his widow's whereabouts is not known.

127. **GraveStone127** – Top picture is that of the grave site of Albert Harrison Ariail, son of Luke Ives Ariail. Bottom is that of John Keener Ariail, son of Albert Harrison Ariail. John did not marry.
128. **GraveStone128** – Top picture is of the marker for John Franklin Ariail, son of William Henry Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture is of marker for Rose Griffith, wife of John Franklin Ariail. Buried in Mandarin, Florida.
129. **GraveStone129** – Top picture is of the plot for William Henry Ariail, son of John Franklin Ariail. His wife has since passed and is probably buried next to him. There was no stone at time picture was taken but corners of the grave plot had markers with an "A" on them. Bottom picture is of family lot for Frank Joseph Diorio, Sr. and his wife Edna Gertrude Ariail. Edna is the daughter of John Franklin Ariail. This grave is in a very large cemetery and we were looking without any clue as to where the grave was located. It was also very hot and my wife Lorraine said she prayed that God would show us where to go. When she opened her eyes, she saw the stone just to her right.
130. **GraveStone130** – Top picture is the marker for Frank Joseph Diorio, Sr., husband of Edna Gertrude Ariail. Bottom is marker for Edna Gertrude Ariail, daughter of John Franklin Ariail.
131. **GraveStone131** – Top picture is markers for James Marvin Allison and his wife Made Rebecca Shirley. James is the son of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail. Bottom are markers for James M. "Jimmie" Allison, Jr., son of James Marvin Allison and to his right is James M. "Chip" Allison, III., son of James M. "Jimmie" Allison, Jr.
132. **GraveStone132** – Top picture is of the grave site of Ervan Mauldin Ariail, Sr., and his wife Ruth Carson Ariail. Ervan is the son of John Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture is of the grave site of Reginald Stanley Ariail before restoration by the Ariail Cemetery Committee. Reginald is the son of Rev. William Hamilton Ariail.
133. **GraveStone133** – Both top and bottom pictures are of the new stone placed on the grave of Reginald Stanley Ariail, son of the Rev. William Hamilton Ariail. This stone was placed by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee with the approval of the Ariail Family Reunion Association.
134. **GraveStone134** – Bottom picture is of the graves of Doyce William Ariail, Sr., and his wife Helen Claire Spearman. Doyce is the son of Thomas Henry Ariail and the father of Lt.Col. Doyce William Ariail, Jr., former President of the Ariail Family Reunion Association.
135. **GraveStone135** – Top picture is of the marker for Frances Lucille Nicholson Ariail, wife of Oscar Lee Ariail. The grave was not marked with a stone when found. This new stone was placed by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee as part of their grave restoration project. Bottom picture is of the marker for (old stone on left) Oscar Lee Ariail, son of John Milton Ariail. The new stone on right is the one for his wife, Frances Lucille Nicholson Ariail.

He was the only son of Big Moses to survive the war, his brothers, George, Lewis and Taylor all died in the Civil War. Right picture is of Olen Thomas Ariail, son of James Claude Ariail, standing at the grave of Frances Lucille Nicholson Ariail, wife of Oscar Lee Ariail during its placement in 1997.
137. **GraveStone137** – Top picture is of the marker for William Henry Harrison Ariail, son of John Harvey Ariail, Jr. Bottom picture is of the stone for Damie Acena Robinson Ariail, wife of William Henry Harrison Ariail.
138. **GraveStone138** – Top picture is of the grave marker for William Fields Ariail, son of William Henry Harrison Ariail. Bottom marker is for Eliza Hallum "Lydia" Smith Ariail, wife of William Fields Ariail.
139. **GraveStone139** – Left picture is that of the Rev. John Harvey Ariail, Jr., son of John Harvey Ariail, Sr. The Rev. John Harvey Ariail, Jr., was born in Southington Connecticut. It is said that when his son Thomas Blessingame Ariail died, John gave his life to the Lord and became a Baptist Minister. He was the Pastor of Enon Baptist Church near Easley, South Carolina and was so widely loved that he had to take a leave of absence from his own ministry to fulfill the demand of other churches for his services. Right picture is that

John Harvey Ariail, Jr. The Ariail Reunion Cemetery Committee desired to upgrade these graves of the Rev. John Harvey Ariail, Jr. and his family but was discouraged from taking any action by the present curators of the cemetery.
141. **GraveStone141** – Left picture is stone for Martha Catherine “Patty” Craig Ariail Pickel, wife of John Harvey Ariail, III who died in Civil War, and 2nd husband William Jacob Pickel. Right picture is that of the stone for John E. Craig, son of Climelia Elizabeth Ariail. John was a Senator for the State of South Carolina.
142. **GraveStone142** – Top picture is the grave marker for Thomas Henry Ariail, son of William Henry Harrison Ariail. May Ellouise Farr Ariail, wife of Thoms Henry Ariail is also on the marker. Bottom picture is of the marker for Jack Ariail and his wife Mary Christine Hester Ariail. Jack is the son of Thomas Henry Ariail.
143. **GraveStone143** – Top picture is that of the graves of William Breckenbridge Hester and his wife Virginia L. Ariail, Virginia is the daughter of William Henry Harrison Ariail. Five of their infant children are also buried in this family lot. Bottom stone is the marker for James Moton “Jay Bird” Carpenter and his wife Mary Elizabeth White. Mary Elizabeth White is the daughter of Jeffie Welborn and granddaughter of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail.
144. **GraveStone144** – Left picture is stone for Sarah Jane Ariail, daughter of the Rev. John Harvey Ariail, Jr. and wife of James Madison Reid. After Sarah Jane Ariail died, her husband remarried and moved to Dublin, Texas with the family. Right picture is the marker for John Harvey Ariail, III, who died of measles in the Civil War. He was the son of the Rev. John Harvey Ariail, Jr.
145. **GraveStone145** – Top is the grave marker for Lawrence F. Curtis and his wife Ruth Lollis Curtis. Lawrence is the step-grandson of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Bottom picture is the markers for Ressie Finely, step-granddaughter of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Silas Fennel Curtis, husband of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail was previously married with a house full of kids. When Lucinda married him, she cared for his children therefore, she has a vast amount of descendants from their marriage.
146. **GraveStone146** – Top family lot is for Luther Henry White, his wife Jeffie Welborn and their son Clyde L. White. Jeffie Welborn is the daughter of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail. The son, Clyde L. White died as a POW in WWII. Bio. Clyde lived in New York City when his mother died. According to Joe Welborn, Clyde was captured by the Japanese in the Philippines and disappeared. His brother Capt. Claude W. White attempted again and again to find him, but do not know whether he did or not. The marker at Fairview may be a memorial marker. Bottom marker is for John Harvey Ariail, Sr., and his wife Beulah Virginia Simpson. John Harvey Ariail, Sr. is the son of William Fields Ariail.
147. **GraveStone147** – Top picture is mausoleum resting place for James Robert Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail and Beulah Taylor McGill. Bottom graves are those of William Harrison Ariail and his wife Beulah Taylor McGill Ariail. William Harrison Ariail is the son of Albert Harrison Ariail. Ruby Mae Jewell Ariail, daughter of William Harrison Ariail is buried next to her mother with no marker when cemetery visited. The husband of Ruby Mae Jewell Ariail, Robert Ernest McKoon, Jr., is buried in a different cemetery. See Cemetery document of the Ariail Web Site.

- 169. GraveStone169** – Top picture is that of identifying marker for Saint Andrews Parish, just outside of Charleston, South Carolina. The bottom picture is of the cemetery for Saint Andrews. This is where the remains of Albert M. Ariail, son of James Ives Ariail, were placed after his body was found on the banks of Cooper River. Bio. Albert M. Ariail was originally listed as being named James Ives Ariail, Jr., in the Ariail genealogy. It was also thought that he drowned while swimming from ship to shore in Charleston Harbor. Documentation obtained on 1 Oct 1996 revealed a different story. Albert died at 11 p.m. on Cooper River, Charleston County when the boat he was in capsized. He had been a seaman for 6 years and was residing at the seaman's home, Charleston, S.C. Effie Leo Ariail stated that James Ives Ariail, Alberts' father, went to Charleston in an attempt to find his son, but was unsuccessful. Albert's remains were, however, found May 1, 1935 in the p.m. on Mount Pleasant Beach. Condition of remains was listed as "terrible". He was buried May 2, 1935 at 2:30 p.m. at St. Andrews Parish Cemetery in the section reserved for Seamen. The Rev. Wallace Mastin, Church of the Redeemer, conducted the funeral. There is the possibility that family members never knew of the finding and burial of Albert because men from the Seamen's Home acted as Pallbearers, and John McAlister, Funeral Director, handled the arrangements as a charity case. The cemetery where Albert is buried is on Rt. 61 N, toward Middleton Gardens, from Charleston, S.C. Death notice appearing in the May 5, 1935, edition of the Charleston Paper reads as follows: Ariail--Albert M., 20, Cooper River. Seamen's cemetery.

180. **GraveStone180** – Picture is of the grave marker for Richard Crayton Oliver and his wife Veda Mae Wilson. Richard is step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
181. **GraveStone181** – Picture is of the grave marker for Jimmy Crayton Oliver, son of Richard Crayton Oliver and Veda Mae Wilson Oliver. He is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
182. **GraveStone182** – Picture is of the grave marker for Olin C. Oliver, son of Reuben Crayton Oliver. He is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
183. **GraveStone183** – Picture is of the grave marker for Michael Eugene Oliver. He is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.

188. **GraveStone188** – Left picture is the marker for Emma Smelley Kerr, 2nd wife of William Henry Kerr who was first married to Mary Lenora Curtis who was a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Right picture is that of Laurine Kerr Harrell, wife of John W. Harrell and step granddaughter of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
189. **GraveStone189** – Left picture is that of the marker for Samuel Cowen Kerr, son of Mary Lenora Curtis who is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Right picture is marker for Benjamin Franklin Kerr, son of Mary Lenora Curtis who is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
190. **GraveStone190** – Left picture is that of Laura Dimsdale Kerr, 3rd wife of William Henry Kerr who was first married to Mary Lenora Curtis who was a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Right picture is marker for Silas Craig Curtis, son of Claude Cleveland Curtis who is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
191. **GraveStone191** – Top picture is grave plot for the McNeill family, descendants of Ila Eulela Ariail, who was daughter of John Alvin Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Lt. Col. Thomas Harold McNeill who is place in the McNeill plot and most likely relative of Ila Eulela Ariail.
192. **GraveStone192** – Top picture is a memorial marker for 2nd Lt. Henry Thomas Gillespie, son of Mary Climelia Ariail. 2nd Lt. Henry Thomas Gillespie is buried in France. A picture of the cemetery is contained within this document. Bio. 2nd Lt., 168th Infantry, 42nd Infantry Division. Killed Argonne Forest, France. Buried in France. Henry was of medium height, medium build with light brown hair and light brown eyes. Buried in the Meuse-Argonne American Cemetery, Romange-sous-Montfaucon, Meuse, France. Buried in Plot F, Row 20, Grave 22. Bottom picture is of the family plot and marker for William Henry Thomas Gillespie and his wife Mary Climelia Gillespie, daughter of William Harrison Ariail. Their son’s memorial marker is in the same family plot. This entire plot, including stones, was cleaned and upgraded by the Ariail Family Reunion Cemetery Committee under one of their projects. See Historical/Cemetery Committee reports for further information. The U.S. Government offered to send Mary Climelia Ariail to France, after the war, to visit her son’s grave, but because of health and advanced age, she did not go.
193. **GraveStone193** – Top picture is of the family plot for Clay Broughton Coffee and his wife Lucille Lowder. Clay is the son of Dora Letitia Ariail. Bottom picture is grave plot for Rita Ariail, daughter of John Harrison Ariail. The graves of her two husbands are unknown.
194. **GraveStone194** – Top picture is of the family plot of John Harrison Ariail, his wife Ola Mae “Mammie” Huff and their daughter Ossie Lee Ariail. The bottom picture is of the stone of Walter H. Ariail, son of John Harrison Ariail. It is said that Walter died from a broken neck after diving into a bin of cotton seed.
195. **GraveStone195** – Left picture is large family marker for James Leland Ariail and his wife Lettie Meticia Duncan. This stone is within a family plot containing many graves. The large stone and all stones contained within this family plot were straightened, cleaned, coping put around the graves, weed killer and heavy plastic put upon the ground and chipped stone placed over the grave. The work was accomplished by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee. Right picture is of the marker for Exie Lucile Ariail and Ola Inez Ariail, both daughter of John Harrison Ariail.

- 196. GraveStone196** – The left picture is marker for Moses B. Ariail, son of John Milton Ariail. This grave is contained within the James Leland Ariail family plot and has been upgraded by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee as described in work done under GraveStone194. Right picture is marker for Lemuel Lawrence Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail. This family member died in the Civil War from measles. It is said that his father, William Harrison Ariail, upon the death of his son, stated ‘We are going to bury my son in the Church Yard because the way this War is going, we may not own our farm much longer’. It is believed that Lemuel Lawrence Ariail was the first person buried at Nails Creek Baptist Church in Banks County, Georgia. It should be noted that up until that time, most families buried their dead in the back yard of their homes. By the Grace of God, William did not lose his farm and his descendants still live and farm there. This grave is contained within the family plot of James Leland Ariail. The Ariail Family Cemetery Committee has upgraded this entire area, cleaned the original stone and requested and placed a new military marker at the foot of the grave.
- 197. GraveStone197** – Left picture is of the original stone for Mary Adelaide Barr, wife of William Harrison Ariail. The family always thought the Ariail family was Irish, however; this is not true. The Irish linkage in the family comes from Mary Adelaide Barr, daughter of Andrew Warnock, immigrants from Ireland. The Ariail ancestor came from France. Right picture is of the original stone for William Harrison Ariail, son of Esq. Ens. John Harvey Ariail, Sr., who was born in Connecticut. The Ariail Cemetery Committee has placed a new family stone on these graves. They are contained within the same family plot as James Leland Ariail. See his entry for grave work done for this family plot.
- 198. GraveStone198** – Top picture is of the original marker for William D. Wiley, 1st husband of Mary Climelia Ariail. Bottom marker is for the grave of Thomas B. Wiley, son of Mary Climelia Ariail. These stones have been replaced with new markers, coping put around the grave site, plastic and chipped stone over the graves. This work was accomplished as part of the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee work.
- 199. GraveStone199** – Top picture is of the family plot for Delbert Calvin Ariail and his wife, Woodie Faye Lewallen. Delbert is the son of James Claude Ariail. Bottom picture is of the family lot for James Claude Ariail and his wife Vastie Bellamy. This grave plot has been upgraded under the work of the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee. James Claude Ariail is the son of James Leland Ariail.
- 200. GraveStone200** – Top picture is of the grave plot for William Boyd Ariail and his wife Mildred Chambers. William Boyd Ariail is the son of James Claude Ariail and the father of Keith Ariail, Ariail Family Reunion President. Bottom picture is family marker for the graves of Kermit Parks Ariail and his wife Allie Neoma Grizzle. Kermit is the son of James Claude Ariail.
- 201. GraveStone201** – Top and bottom pictures are of the Patterson Family cemetery. John M. Patterson, his wife Sarah Annette Means and their son James L. Patterson are the marked graves in this ancient cemetery. They are the great grandparents of James W. Patterson, Family Historian. James is the son of Lillie Blanche Ariail. There are in excess of 80 graves in this cemetery and it was originally located in the back yard of the Patterson Farm. There are many such cemeteries in this area with the location of many such family cemeteries are no longer known.
- 202. GraveStone202** – Top picture is of the family plot for the McCreary Family in Aiken, South Carolina. Bottom picture is of the grave marker for Lucile McCreary, wife of Davies Marvin Ariail.
- 203. GraveStone203** – Left picture is markers of the Furse Family in Yemassee, South Carolina. Right picture is marker for Annie Furse, wife of Warren Galloway Ariail, Sr.
- 204. GraveStone204** – Top picture is another view of the Furse Family plot in Yemassee, South Carolina. Bottom picture is the family plot for Mack Pearson Henderson, husband of Mary Louise Ariail. Mary Louise Ariail is buried in a different cemetery as Mack remarried.
- 205. GraveStone205** – Left picture is marker for Nancy Donie Scarborough, wife of Claude Cleveland Curtis. Right picture is marker for Claude Cleveland Curtis, stepson of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
- 206. GraveStone206** – Top picture is of two Curtis family grave lots. Waymond Edward “Wayne” Curtis and his wife Lois Leila Kinchen and Claude Cleveland Curtis and his wife Nancy Donie Scarborough. These are step descendants of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Seigler family plot in Milan, Georgia. These are step descendants of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.

- 207. GraveStone207** – Picture is of the grave marker for Eugene Joseph Silva and his wife Ruth Adele Curtis. Ruth is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
- 208. GraveStone208** – Left picture is of marker for Rachel Kerr, wife of Henry Grady Seigler. Rachel is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Right picture is marker for Henry Grady Seigler.
- 209. GraveStone209** – Left marker is for Samuel “Sam” Sylvester Curtis, stepson of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Right marker is for LeRoy Curtis, son of Samuel “Sam” Sylvester Curtis.
- 210. GraveStone210** – Top picture is marker for Alfred Silas Curtis and wife Pauline Wallace. Alfred is step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Clarence Claude Curtis and wife Billie Mae Gray. Clarence is step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
- 211. GraveStone211** – Top picture is marker for John Augustus Dowdy, husband of Frances Lorene Curtis. Frances is step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Frances Lorene Curtis, step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.
- 212. GraveStone212** – Top picture is of the marker for Lana Editha Dowdy, daughter of Frances Lorene Curtis who is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Bottom picture is of the Memorial to the Confederate Soldiers at Fredericksburg, Virginia. Many of our cousins served and several died in that conflict.
- 213. GraveStone213** – Top and bottom pictures are of the Confederate Cemetery at Fredericksburg, Virginia. See GraveStone212 also.
- 214. GraveStone214** – Top picture is of the memorial marker for mass graves of the Confederate Soldiers who died at Manassas, Virginia. William Ira Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail died at this place. Bottom picture is the marker for the mass grave of the Confederate Soldiers who died in the Battle of The Wilderness, Virginia. Samuel Albert Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail died in this battle.
- 215. GraveStone215** – Both top and bottom pictures are a monument erected to the memory of the Confederate soldiers who died at Manassas, Virginia. The bodies were originally buried in shallow graves in the farmers’ fields but the farmers were plowing up the bones. Those bones were then removed from the fields and buried in a mass grave. William Ira Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail is said to have died in a Field Hospital in Manassas. His remains were probably a part of these soldiers, therefore, this monument would be in his memory.
- 216. GraveStone216** – Both top and bottom pictures are two more views of the beautiful monument erected to the Confederate soldiers as described in GraveStone215.
- 217. GraveStone217** – Both top and bottom pictures are monuments erected to the Confederate soldiers who were killed at the ‘Battle of the Wilderness, Spotsylvania, Virginia’ and buried in a mass grave. Samuel Albert Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail died in that battle and is probably buried here.
- 218. GraveStone218** – Top picture is individual markers for some Confederate soldiers who died in the Battle of the Wilderness. Samuel Albert Ariail’s name was not listed, therefore, if his remains were recovered, they were probably buried in a mass grave. Bottom picture is another view of the picture contained in GraveStone217.
- 219. GraveStone219** – In picture, stone on left with flowers is that of Oscar Lee Ariail after it was cleaned in one of our restoration projects. The stone on the right is that of a new stone placed by Ariail Family Cemetery Committee on an unmarked grave for Frances Lucille Nicholson, wife of Oscar Lee Ariail. Oscar Lee Ariail is the son of John Milton Ariail, a Civil War Veteran.
- 220. GraveStone220** – Top picture is a new marker placed by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee on the unmarked grave of Elizabeth “Lizzie” Henderson, wife of Guy Otis Ariail Bottom picture is a new marker placed by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee on the unmarked grave of Guy Otis Ariail. Guy is the son of Oscar Lee Ariail.
- 221. GraveStone221** – Top picture is another view of the new stones placed by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee on the unmarked graves of Guy Otis Ariail and his wife Elizabeth “Lizzie” Henderson. Bottom picture is of the marker for John Whitt Hamilton, Sr., and his wife Frances Viola Cox. John is a descendant of Climelia Abigail Ariail.
- 222. GraveStone222** – Top picture is of the family lot for Felton Allen Ariail and his wife Imogene Anglin. Felton is the son of James Claude Ariail. Bottom picture is the marker for Ellis Newt Garrison and his wife Bessie Eller Ariail. Bessie is the daughter of James Leland Ariail.

- 223. GraveStone223** – Top picture is the grave marker for two of the sons of James Claude Ariail, one unnamed, called Little Son Ariail and the other named Aubrey Ariail. Bottom picture is of the family lot of William Glenn Patterson and his wife Lillie Blanche Ariail. Lillie is the daughter of James Claude Ariail.
- 224. GraveStone224** – Top picture is family lot marker for Joseph Albert Ariail, Jr. Joseph is the son of Joseph Albert Ariail, Sr. Bottom marker is for Joseph Albert Ariail, Jr. His wife, Geneva Lucille Ritchie has since passed and is buried in the same family lot.
- 225. GraveStone225** – Picture is marker for Geneva Lucile Ritchie, wife of Joseph Albert Ariail, Jr.
- 226. GraveStone226** – Top picture is grave stone for Ira Vandiver Ariail and his wife Julia Ann Cochran. Ira is the son of Andrew Daniel Ariail, a Civil War Veteran. Bottom picture is of the marker for Frederick Ariail, son of Ira Vandiver Ariail.
- 227. GraveStone227** – Top picture is of the grave marker for Bertie Mae Ariail, daughter of Ira Vandiver Ariail and husband of William Fears Stovall. Bottom picture is of marker for William Fears Stovall.
- 228. GraveStone228** – Top picture is of the grave site of Robert Buford Ariail and his wife Martha E. “Mattie” Ayers. Robert is the son of Ira Vandiver Ariail. Bottom picture is of the South End Cemetery in Southington, Connecticut. After extensive research, both we and the people maintaining the South End Cemetery believe that John Ariail and his wife Hannah Rich are buried here. John Ariail is the son of Charles Ariail from Mouzillon, Village, France.
- 229. GraveStone229** – Two pictures of South End Cemetery, Southington, Connecticut. In the bottom picture, the grassy area on the bottom side of the road is the area where the cemetery officials placed, for the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee, a memorial stone for Jean Baptiste Mathias Ariail and his wife Hannah Rich. Although records are not complete enough for this cemetery, the cemetery officials feel that John Ariail and Hannah are buried here and they wanted to recognize them with the memorial stone. A pink dogwood tree was planted at the memorial marker. It is also possible that Luke Ariail, son of John Ariail buried one of his young sons here in this cemetery.
- 230. GraveStone230** – Top picture is another view of South End Cemetery. Bottom picture is of the cemetery for the Catholic Church. Although John Ariail was Catholic, he attended the Congregational Church in Southington, Connecticut. The records are complete for the Catholic Cemetery and John Ariail, nor any of his family are buried there.
- 231. GraveStone231** – Two more pictures of the Catholic Graveyard. Note the mountains in the background. According to deeds and documentation, John Ariail owned 7 acres of land and a home at the base of these mountains.
- 232. GraveStone232** – Left marker is for Isaac Stearns, the 3rd husband of Lucy Ariail. Lucy Ariail is the daughter of Jean-Baptiste Mathias Ariail. Right picture is the marker for Horace Goodrich and his wife Delia Ariail. Delia is the daughter of Luke Ariail from Connecticut.
- 233. GraveStone233** – Top picture is marker for Sabra Maty Ariail, daughter of Luke Ariail. Sabra lived in Connecticut; New Orleans, Louisiana and according to family lore, once came through Georgia and South Carolina gathering signatures to probate the will of her uncle, Manna Rich Ariail after his death in Louisiana. Bottom picture is marker for Abigail Prentice, wife of Luke Ariail. The Ariail Family Cemetery Committee placed two stones for family members on unmarked graves in this cemetery.
- 234. GraveStone234** – Top picture is the marker for Ellen A. Goodrich, daughter of Delia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for relatives of Horace Goodrich, husband of Delia Ariail.
- 235. GraveStone235** – The following is a series of pictures of the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee restoration project for William Harrison Ariail and his wife Mary Adelaide Barr and their descendants. Top picture is starting to dig up existing site. Bottom picture is a new marker for William Harrison Ariail and his wife Mary Adelaide Barr placed between the old markers. Family members wanted the old markers to stay in place. William Harrison Ariail is the son of John Harvey Ariail, Sr., who was born in Connecticut.
- 236. GraveStone236** – Two more pictures of the stone of William Harrison Ariail and Mary Adelaide Barr. These are not pictures of the completed project. Old stones were washed, coping put around graves with plastic to keep grass and weeds away and chipped stone over the plastic.

- 237. GraveStone237** – The two stones were placed by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee. Top picture is marker for Guynell Ariail, daughter of Guy Otis Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Frances Ruth Ariail, daughter of Guy Otis Ariail.
- 238. GraveStone238** – Top picture is another view of the stones for Guynell Ariail and her sister Frances Ruth Ariail. The only way these unmarked graves were located was by an elderly lady in the church showing and telling the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee “that her mother told her that two young girls were buried in that spot without stones”. Bottom picture is marker for Milton Neal Campbell and his wife Bobbie Lou Robertson. Although the marker does not contain Bobbie, she has since passed and is buried in the cemetery with him. Milton Neal Campbell is a descendant of Ila Eulela Ariail.
- 239. GraveStone239** – Top picture is family lot for Lloyd Broughton Ariail and his wife Pearl Stephens. Although not marked at time picture was taken, both have passed. Lloyd is the son of John Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for Sandra Kay Ariail, daughter of Lloyd Broughton Ariail.
- 240. GraveStone240** – Top picture is of the grave stone for Col. David William Ariail and his wife Ina Estella Mauldin. Col. David William Ariail is the son of David Blassingham Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for Mary Harvick, wife of Andrew Warnock. She is the mother of Mary Adelaide Barr who became the wife of William Harrison Ariail. She is buried in the Pickens Chapel Cemetery near the place where John Harvey Ariail and Chloe Ives are interred. Her father was from Craig’s Head, Ireland; therefore, this is why the Ariail family in the Nails Creek Community always thought the Ariail’s came from Ireland.
- 241. GraveStone241** – Top picture is of the marker for Col Samuel Greenfield Barr, father of Mary Adelaide Barr who is the wife of William Harrison Ariail. They are buried near the place where John Harvey Ariail, Sr., father of William Harrison Ariail is buried. Bottom picture is marker for Mary Warnock, wife of Col. Samuel Greenfield Barr before it was restored by descendants of the Barr family from Colorado. This restoration was accomplished in coordination between the Barr family genealogists and the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee.
- 242. GraveStone242** – Both pictures are of the Pickens Chapel Cemetery in Slabtown, South Carolina. The graves are of Col. Samuel Greenfield Barr and his wife Mary Warnock. You will note a new stone in the upper left corner of the bottom picture. That is the stone for Esq. Ens. John Harvey Ariail, Sr., and his wife Chloe Ives.
- 243. GraveStone243** – Top picture another view of the graves of Col. Samuel Greenfield Barr and his wife before graves were upgraded. The bottom picture is a marker at the Hollywood Cemetery in Richmond, Virginia. A story passed down through the Ariail family was that Harvey Orlando Ariail, a Civil War soldier, and son of Luke Ives Ariail, was discharged from service in Richmond and disappeared on his way home. The Ariail Cemetery Committee Chairman decided to investigate this matter and eventually found his death records. He died in the hospital in Richmond, Virginia and was buried in the Hollywood Cemetery in that city, located on the banks of the beautiful James River. The people in charge of the cemetery had mistakenly listed the person interred in the grave under the wrong name. The Ariail Cemetery Committee, in conjunction with the cemetery officials, located the exact grave site, ordered a proper military marker, and now, at last, Harvey Orlando Ariail can rest in peace with the remainder of the Ariail family knowing what happened to him and where he is interred. Just as the military motto is “that we will never leave one of our members behind”, as long as I, as Cemetery Committee Chairman live, I shall never leave one of our family members behind. We put our family motto on the grave stone of Esq. Ens. John Harvey Ariail, Sr., and his wife Chloe Climelia Ives. It reads [“We shall never forget”](#). Need anyone in our family say more!
- 244. GraveStone244** – Two pictures of the Memorial Monument erected to the Confederate Soldiers who died in Richmond. Located in Hollywood Cemetery, Richmond.
- 245. GraveStone245** – Inscriptions on the side of the Confederate Memorial in Hollywood Cemetery.
- 246. GraveStone246** – Top picture is of the marker for Winslow L. “Cub” Brooks and his wife Essie Ora Mauldin. Essie is the daughter of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for Joseph Doil Brooks, son of Essie Ora Mauldin.
- 247. GraveStone247** – Top picture is of the markers for Henry Walter Brooks and Tathina Annette Brooks, children of Essie Ora Mauldin, Bottom picture is marker for Capt. Leon Ariail “Snake” Hendricks and his wife Mary Durham. Capt. Leon is a descendant of Eliza Mildred Ariail.

248. [GraveStone248](#) – Top picture is marker for Lt. Smith Griffin Hendricks. He is a descendant of Eliza Mildred Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Lt. Col. Edwin Ariail “Bud” Kinard and his wife Helen Hunter Gresham. Lt. Col. Edwin is the son of Moida Lucile “Dearie” Ariail. We do not know if Helen has yet passed.
249. [GraveStone249](#) – Top picture is marker for Eva M. Gibson, wife of Edgar Julian Mauldin. Edgar is son of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Hovey Welborn and his wife Gertrude McCollum. Hovey is the son of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail.
250. [GraveStone250](#) -- Top picture is marker for George Earl Mauldin, son of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail. We have been unable to determine what happened to his wife or children. Bottom picture is marker for Edgar Julien Mauldin, son of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail. His wife Eva M. Gibson is buried in same cemetery.
251. [GraveStone251](#) – Left picture is marker for Little Jeff Welborn, son of Hovey Welborn and grandson of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail. Right picture is marker for Arden Nevill Welborn, son of Hovey Welborn.
252. [GraveStone252](#) – Top picture is marker for Lucile Welborn and Infant son Welborn, both children of Hovey Welborn. Bottom picture is marker for Nally family, relatives of Matilda Catherine Barr who is related to Mary Adelaide Barr, wife of William Harrison Ariail.
253. [GraveStone253](#) – Top picture is that of Lorraine Patterson, wife of James Patterson, Chairman of Ariail Cemetery Committee, standing at the graves of Wylie Neal Welborn and his wife Frances Couch. Bottom picture is of grave marker for Wylie Neal Welborn and his wife Frances Couch. Wylie is descendant of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail.
254. [GraveStone254](#) – Top picture is that of the marker for Colie Blease Barr, nephew of Mary Adelaide Barr who was wife of William Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for Joseph Archie “Joe” McKee, Sr., and his wife Geraldine Whitlock. Joseph is a descendant of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail.
255. [GraveStone255](#) -- Top picture is marker for Lewis Archie Mckee and his wife Mabel Florence “Maybelle” Brooks. Maybelle is a descendant of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail. Bottom picture is the marker for John Wickliffe Hamilton, son of Andrew Robinson Hamilton from the Climelia Abigail Ariail family line.
256. [GraveStone256](#) -- Top picture is grave marker for James William “Jim” Womack and his wife Martha Lusk Poore. James is a descendant of Denise Ethel Ariail. Bottom picture is grave marker, in same plot as top picture, is that of Frances L. Brock. Connection to family unknown at this time.
257. [GraveStone257](#) – Left picture is grave marker for Lula Meadows, wife of Guy Ariail Curtis. Guy is the son of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Right picture is marker for Guy Ariail Curtis.
258. [GraveStone258](#) – Top picture is marker for Paul and Ruth Crow, Great grandnephew of Mary Adelaide Barr Ariail, wife of William Harrison Ariail. Many pictures of grave stones for the Barr family are contained in the Ariail Library, but few are included in this document. Bottom picture is of the grave marker for Shirley Jacqueline Hodge, wife of Lt.Col. Doyce William Ariail. Lt. Col. Doyce Ariail was President of the Ariail Reunion Association for many years. His wife, Shirley, died in a tragic accident after visiting with her husband who was at that time serving in Vietnam. All of her sons survived the accident and attend the reunion on a regular basis.
259. [GraveStone259](#) – Top picture is marker for the grave of Carter William Holcombe, husband of Velma Geneva Ariail, daughter of Vincent Dallas “Dad” Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Sandra Jo Lyles, daughter of Betty Imogene Ariail.
260. [GraveStone260](#) – Top picture is of the marker for Frank Edwin Woodard and his wife Odessa Ariail. Odessa is the daughter of Vincent Dallas “Dad” Ariail. Bottom marker is for the Patterson Family lot in the Rose Lane Cemetery in Toccoa, Georgia.
261. [GraveStone261](#) – Left picture is marker for John Trenton Patterson, son of Lillie Blanche Ariail. Right picture is marker for SCPO, James Wayne Patterson, USN, Retired and his wife Lorraine Anne Kimball Patterson. Both are in the James and Lorraine Patterson family lot in Toccoa, Georgia.
262. [GraveStone262](#) – Top picture is the marker for Maurice Leroy “Bubba” Vaughn, Jr., a descendant of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail. Bottom picture is the marker for Mattie Iona Welborn, a descendant of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail.
263. [GraveStone263](#) – Top picture is marker for Harry L. Welborn, a descendant of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Mary Estell Winningham, wife of Frank Albert Welborn who is son of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail.

Bottom picture is grave marker for Alvin George Leverett, Jr., and his wife Edna Louise Wall. Alvin is a grand nephew of Mary Adelaide Barr, wife of William Harrison Ariail.
- 267. GraveStone267** – Top picture is marker for Elmer Lee Mauldin, a descendant of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail. Bottom Picture is marker for William Lawrence Mauldin and his wife Agnes Destamony “Dessie” Hayes. William is the son of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail.
- 268. GraveStone268** – Top picture is marker for George Jefferson Jenkins and his wife Lucille Pryor. Lucille is the daughter of Lillie Beatrice Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Rev. Marlin Blease Mauldin and his wife Eva Bell “Dessie” Edgar. Marlin is a descendant of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail.
- 269. GraveStone269** – Top picture is of the grave marker for Lee Elmer Mauldin. Lee is a descendant of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail. Bottom picture is a marker for William Lawrence Mauldin and his wife Agnes Destamony “Dessie” Hayes. William is the son of Parthenia Aurelia Ariail.
- 270. GraveStone270** – Top picture is the grave stone for family of Elmer Vernon Forrest. Bottom picture is the marker for Elmer Vernon Forrest and Lillian Elsie Abderhalden. Elmer is the son of Flora Delia Ariail.
- 271. GraveStone271** – Top picture is the grave markers for Wallace Weed and his wife Elizabeth Hunter. They are the parents of two children who married into the Ariail family. Bottom picture is of marker for Mary Gordon Weed, wife of Herbert Joyner Ariail and her daughter Margaret Elizabeth Ariail. Herbert is the son of Stokes Smith Ariail.
- 272. GraveStone272** -- Top picture is marker for Stokes Smith Ariail and his wife Minnie Hannah Climena Pixley, their son Herbert Joyner Ariail and their daughter Mary Elizabeth Ariail. Stokes Smith Ariail is the son of Col. Manna Rich Ariail from Louisiana. Stokes Smith Ariail had a difficult substance abuse problem and his wife Hannah lived a very difficult life because of her husband problem. Her diary was converted into a stage production and ran yearly in the area where she lived. The book concerning her life is in the possession of the Ariail library. Bottom picture is of the marker for Marcel Emil Touponce and his wife Lila Field Ariail. Lila is the daughter of Herbert Joyner Ariail. Although Lila is listed on the marker, she is buried in Clearwater, Florida.
- 273. GraveStone273** – Left picture is of the marker for Charles Theodore Weed and his wife Juanita Veronica Ariail. Juanita is the daughter of Stokes Smith Ariail. Rodney Bruce Andrews and his wife Florence Elizabeth Weed are on the same stone. Rodney has since passed. Florence Elizabeth Weed is the daughter of Juanita Veronica Ariail. Right picture is the Churchill family plot and marker with Lorraine Anne Patterson standing at its side. Eliza Selina Ariail, wife of William Curtis Churchill, and their children Horace Churchill and Isabell Churchill are listed on the large marker. Eliza Selina Ariail is the daughter of Luke Ariail from Southington, Connecticut.
- 274. GraveStone274** – Left picture is marker for Sabra Maty Ariail, daughter of Luke Ariail from Connecticut. Sabra Maty Ariail was a traveler in those early times. We have learned that she not only lived in Massachusetts, she was with her siblings in Louisiana and even visited her cousins in Georgia and South Carolina. Right picture is grave marker of Abigail Prentice, wife of Luke Ariail. Luke is buried in Bethlehem, Connecticut.
- 275. GraveStone275** – Left picture is of marker for Horace Goodrich and his wife Delia Ariail. Delia is the daughter of Luke Ariail. Right picture is marker for David Goodrich and his wife S. Eliza Hunt. Although I have him listed as a son of Delia Ariail on the margin that is incorrect.
- 276. GraveStone276** – Left picture is the marker for Ann Eliza Coons, daughter of Lucy Emeline Ariail. We have never found the graves of her father James Mathews Coons and mother Lucy Emeline Ariail. Lucy died in Louisiana. Right picture is marker for Grace Louise Goodrich. Although I have her listed as a granddaughter of Delia Ariail, that note is incorrect.

- 277. GraveStone277** – Left picture is marker for Ellen A. Goodrich, daughter of Delia Ariail. Right picture is marker for Horace Churchill and Isabell Churchill, children of Eliza Selina Ariail.
- 278. GraveStone278** – Top picture is marker for Elizia Selina Ariail, wife of William Curtis Churchill and daughter of Luke Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Flora Delia Ariail and her husband Elmer Lester Forrest. Flora is the daughter of Stokes Smith Ariail.
- 279. GraveStone279** – Top picture is of the beautifully restored grave site of William Harrison Ariail and Mary Adelaide Barr. William Harrison Ariail is the son of Esq. Ens. John Harvey Ariail, Sr., and his wife Chloe Climelia Ives. Bottom picture is marker for Lemuel Lawrence Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail who died in the Civil War. The grave site was brought to this state of appearance by the Ariail Cemetery Committee in conjunction with the approval of the Ariail Family Reunion Association. Note: All improvement projects will bear this same caveat although it might be mentioned in the grave bio.
- 280. GraveStone280** – Left picture is of the marker for Narcissa E. “Northy” Hendricks, wife of John Milton Ariail. Northy was previously married with her husband dying in the Civil War. John Milton Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail, also served in the Civil War, being wounded at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. In that battle, he was fighting against his cousin, Phinehas Dunham from the Minnesota Regiment. Phinehas was also wounded and died from his wounds. He is interred in the Minnesota Regiment Cemetery at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. When John Milton Ariail returned home, he married the widow Northy, raised her children, and fathered 6 children of his own. It is said that one of the things that Northy always said was “I don’t owe nobody nothing”. Right picture is of the marker for John Milton Ariail. These are foot markers. This site was also restored by the Ariail Cemetery Committee.
- 281. GraveStone281** – Left picture is of marker for John Milton Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail. Right picture is marker for William Harrison “Billy” Ariail, son of John Milton Ariail. Billy married Olivia Addington, but don’t know what happened to her. These graves brought up to this standard by the Ariail Cemetery Committee.
- 282. GraveStone282** – These two pictures are of the project to upgrade the graves of John Milton Ariail and his family. Work done by Ariail Cemetery Committee.
- 283. GraveStone283** – Additional views of the work done on the family plot of John Milton Ariail. Work done by Ariail Cemetery Committee.
- 284. GraveStone284** – Additional views of the same work for John Milton Ariail.
- 285. GraveStone285** – This is the finished product of restoration to John Milton Ariail family lot. Note all the work that had to be done to the embankment to ensure erosion does not deteriorate the grave site.
- 286. GraveStone286** – Initial stages of work on the John Milton Ariail family lot. Boy was it a hot day that day.
- 287. GraveStone287** – The last pictures in this series of John Milton Ariail grave site. Finally getting it laid out and getting ready to make it look good.
- 288. GraveStone288** – Left is a duplicate of bottom picture GraveStone254. Right picture is getting ready to repair stone for Climelia Abigail Ariail, daughter of Esp. Ens. John Harvey Ariail, Sr. This work being done by Ariail Cemetery Committee.
- 289. GraveStone289** – Both pictures are of the marker for Climelia Abigail Ariail, daughter of Esq. Ens. John Harvey Ariail, Sr. This work being done by Ariail Cemetery Committee.
- 290. GraveStone290** – Top picture is for marker of Albert Coady Dalton and his wife Nathalee Waldrop. Albert is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for Lewis Lesesne “Tim” Hendricks. Lewis is a descendant of Eliza Mildred Ariail.
- 291. GraveStone291** – Top picture is marker for Derrick Alan Lankford, a descendant of Mary Jacqueline Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for the family plot of Ezekiel Bright Smith and his wife Lillian Modena Ariail. Their daughter Lillian Smith is also interred in the family plot. The Ariail Family Cemetery Committee did an upgrade to this entire lot. Lillian Modena Ariail is the daughter of William Henry Harrison Ariail.
- 292. GraveStone292** – Another view of the Smith family lot and the work done by the Ariail Cemetery Committee.
- 293. GraveStone293** – Left picture is of the marker for Ezekiel Bright Smith, husband of Lillian Modena Ariail. Right picture is of the large family marker.

- 294. GraveStone294** – Top and bottom pictures are of the parsonage and Catholic Church at St. Dennis, Quebec Province, Canada which was where Priest Edouard Quertier, a first cousin of William Harrison Ariail, ministered. Notice the high statue of the Priest in front of the church. It is said that the Priest Quertier was buried beneath the pulpit of the church. Priest Quertier was the grandson of Jean-Baptiste Mathias Ariail.
- 295. GraveStone295** – Top picture is another image of a Confederate Civil War Memorial erected in memory of those who lost their lives in the war. Bottom picture is of the marker for Beulah Elizabeth Lesley, wife of Charlie Jefferson Johnson. Charlie is a descendant of Elizabeth Climelia Ariail.
- 296. GraveStone296** – Top picture is grave marker for William Harrison Ariail and his wife Beulah Taylor McGill. Willis the son of Albert Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture is marker in mausoleum for James Robert Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail.
- 297. GraveStone297** – Picture is of the marker for Charles Frank Ariail, husband of Margaret Largacci and son of John Franklin Ariail.
- 298. GraveStone298** – Top picture is cemetery where John Prentice Ariail is most likely buried in Franklin, Louisiana. His sister, Lucy Emeline Ariail may also be interred here. They were the son and daughter of Luke Ariail from Connecticut. In addition to these two, Manna Rich Ariail (brother of Luke Ariail), Julius Deming Ariail and Judge Manna Rich Ariail, children of Luke Ariail were also in Louisiana. One of the other Ariail girls, Sabra Maty Ariail also lived there for a while. Bottom picture is one of the many beautiful homes that existed during the time they were living there and are still in mint condition today.
- 299. GraveStone299** – Top picture is another of the beautiful homes in Franklin, Louisiana. Bottom picture is grave marker for John Blackman Ariail, Sr., son of Julius Fellows Ariail, II., and husband of Mary Frances Hornsby.
- 300. GraveStone300** – Both pictures are of the tomb of Col. Manna Rich Ariail in the Cyprus Grove Cemetery #1 in New Orleans, Louisiana. When we located the tomb, which is the Tomb of Joseph Foy, it was in bad shape. Caulking was absent from the seams, the structure of the tomb was cracked, portions of the iron fence around the tomb was missing. The Ariail Cemetery Committee took this on as a project in conjunction with one of his descendants, John Ariail, who lives there in Louisiana and the brought the tomb back into integrity with a great deal of expense to the Committee and family. See other documents in the Ariail Family Web Site for further details on this distinguished member of our family and his impact on the area in which he lived during his short life. There will be other pictures of this tomb within this index.
- 301. GraveStone301** – Left picture is marker for Dr. Albert Perry Ross, husband of Janet Carolyn Cureton. Right picture is marker for Janet Carolyn Cureton, a descendant of Climelia Abigail Ariail.
- 302. GraveStone302** – Additional pictures for GraveStone300 and 301 above.
- 303. GraveStone303** – These two pictures are more stones placed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee. They are located in the Bethlehem Cemetery in Bethlehem, Connecticut. The family lived in this town when these family members died. They were placed in graves which became unmarked over the decades, but with the assistance of the cemetery staff, we were able to locate the graves. The top left marker is for Charles P. Ariail, son of John Prentice Ariail. The top right marker is for Eliza Alice Ariail, daughter of Luke Ariail and his wife Abigail Prentice. The bottom left marker is for Eliza Alice Ariail (same as top right) and the bottom right picture is of Luke Ariail. Luke Ariail is the son of Jean-Baptiste Mathias (John) Ariail and his wife Hannah Rich.
- 304. GraveStone304** – Top picture shows the general condition of stones in the ancient Bethlehem Cemetery. Bottom is another picture of the stone we place for our family there.
- 305. GraveStone305** – Top picture is another view of the marker the Ariail Cemetery Committee placed for Luke Ariail, brother of John Harvey Ariail, Sr., who came from Connecticut to South Carolina in 1795. Bottom picture is of the grave marker for Hubert Freeman Ariail and his wife Mildred Beatrice Hearn. Hubert is the son of James Claude Ariail and Vastie Bellamy.
- 306. GraveStone306** – Top picture is the front of the family marker for Hubert Freeman Ariail and his wife Mildred Beatrice Hearn. Bottom picture is marker for Iola Charlotte Chandler, a descendant of Mary Arial from the family line of Michel Arial.
- 307. GraveStone307** – Top picture is marker for Leon Edgar Silenas Chandler and his wife Cora Ellen H. St. George. Cora is the daughter of Mary Arial from the family line of Michel Arial. The bottom picture is,

another of the Ariail Cemetery Committees' projects, that of the new marker provided for Katherine Ethel Ariail, daughter of John Alvin Ariail. She is interred in the Somerset Hills Memorial Park, Bashing Ridge, New Jersey.

308. **GraveStone308** – Another project successfully completed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee. See bottom picture of GraveStone307 above.
309. **GraveStone309** – Top picture is of the grave marker for Edward Henry Ariel and his family. You will notice that the family stone lists the name as Ariel. Edward is the son of Michel Ariel and Margaret E. "Maggie" Martin. Listed on the stone are Edward Henry Ariel and his wife Margaret E. "Maggie" Martin, their daughter Evelyn A. Ariel, his mother Margaret E. "Maggie" Martin, and his son, John Sheridan Ariel. The other two ladies listed, Mary Rayne and Susan Coughlan are probably related to his wife. Bottom picture is of the front of the family marker and the person writing down the data is Lorraine Anne Patterson.
310. **GraveStone310** – Top picture is of the inurnment of Lillian Irene McNeil Kimball, mother of Lorraine Anne Kimball Patterson who is wife of James W. Patterson, Family Historian. Bottom picture is of the beautiful Au Sable River near the place where Michel Ariail, son of Jean-Baptiste Mathias Ariail lived in New York State.
311. **GraveStone311** – Top picture is the grave marker for Elizabeth Boudumont, wife of Joseph Ariel. We, at this time, do not think this family is connected to our family; however, there is a member of our family that cannot be accounted for as yet. He may have lived and had descendants, just don't know. We do know that the name for some of the Ariel families came from either Arel or Riel, which were prominent in Canada. Bottom picture is the marker for Lewis St. George and his wife Mary Ariel. Mary is the daughter of Michel Ariel and Marie Louise Lemieux.
312. **GraveStone312** – Left picture is the marker for Fred J. Ariel, son of Michel Ariel and Marie Louise Lemieux. Right picture is the family marker for Fred J. Ariel. Listed on the marker are Annette Abigail Calkins, his wife and George H. Ariel, his son.
313. **GraveStone313** – Top picture is someone's pretty dog named Louie. I have no idea how this got into the pictures but thought you might enjoy. Bottom picture is of the Ariail Cemetery Committee project of putting a memorial marker in the South End Cemetery in memory of our ancient grandfather and grandmother, Jean-Baptiste (John) Mathias Ariail and his 2nd wife, Hannah Rich. If ever going though Southington, Connecticut, you must visit this cemetery to honor our ancient grandfather. The following two pictures will be additional pictures of this memorial marker.
314. **GraveStone314** – Picture of the South End Cemetery staff placing a pink dogwood tree and memorial marker for John and Hannah Ariail. As you can see, they allowed this in a vacant space between the city street and the cemetery road. Since John was one of the early settlers of the area, they were happy to do this project for us, of course with our reimbursement to them for their cost.
315. **GraveStone315** – Left picture is another view of the memorial marker and pink dogwood tree. Right picture is another view of the memorial stone.
316. **GraveStone316** – The following series of pictures is the restoration of the family grave plot of Lemuel Greenlee Hamilton and his wife Climelia Abigail Ariail. The grave plot contains the stones for several of their grandchildren, their son John Archibald Hamilton, III, who died in the Civil War, and their son-in-law, William Pickens Hunt who also died in the Civil War. Wanted to include all the pictures taken to show to what extent the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee went to upgrade these old grave sites.
317. **GraveStone317** – Two more pictures of the reconstructions project of the family plot of Lemuel Greenlee Hamilton and his wife Climelia Abigail Ariail by the Ariail Cemetery Committee. The old stones for the grandchildren have been marked and removed, the stones have been cleaned, one large stone is lying flat on ground while a base is being constructed and part of the coping has been placed.
318. **GraveStone318** – Two more views of portions of the reconstruction of the family lot of Lemuel Greenlee Hamilton and his wife Climelia Abigail Ariail by the Ariail Cemetery Committee. Climelia is the daughter of Esq. Ens. John Harvey Ariail, Sr.
319. **GraveStone319** – The job is almost completed in these two pictures. All stones are in place and most of the chipped stone has been place. Still will give a few more pictures so anyone can get a good look at the whole plot.

- 320. GraveStone320** – Bringing in the heavy equipment to move the stones and tons of chipped stone that it took to accomplish the work on this grave plot.
- 321. GraveStone321** – Almost done now, picture 322 will show the finished product.
- 322. GraveStone322** – Compare what this grave site looked like before the Ariail Cemetery Committee took up the project. All the old stones are beautifully cleaned and repaired. New stones for the 5 babies that are buried there, new coping around the graves, heavy gage plastic and weed killer over the entire plot and 4 inches of chipped granite stone over the entire grave site. Alexander Granite in Easley, South Carolina did all of our work and we never had any problems with timeliness or quality of work. Thank you Sid.
- 323. GraveStone323** – Top picture is the marker for Peter Aseria Girard and his wife Cora May Arial. Cora is the daughter of Eugene Stephen Ariail Sr. Bottom picture is the marker for William Wallace Arial and his wife Hosanna Amelia Girard. William is the son of Eugene Stephen Arial, Sr.
- 324. GraveStone324** – Top picture is marker for Nathan M. Lucas, grandson of Theresa May Arial. Theresa May Arial is the daughter of William Wallace Arial. Bottom marker is for Willard Mitchell Arial and his wife Eleanor June Powers. Willard is the son of Eugene Stephen Arial, Sr.
- 325. GraveStone325** – Top picture is marker for Frederick Eugene “Fred” Mascott and his wife Emma Arial. Emma is the daughter of Michel Arial and Marie Louise Lemieux. Bottom picture is marker for Ethel N. Mascott, wife of John L. Lee, Jr., and daughter of Emma Arial. We do not have any data of John L. Lee, Jr.
- 326. GraveStone326** – Left picture is the grave marker for Jean Napoleon Arial, son of Michel Arial and Marie Louise Lemieux. Right picture is of the marker for John Fredette and his wife Eleanor Theresa Arial. Eleanor Theresa Arial is the daughter of Michel Arial and Marie Louise Lemieux.
- 327. GraveStone327** – Top picture is a new marker placed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee on the unmarked grave of Thomas Hamilton Boggs. We had a very difficult time finding his grave site, however, a very elderly lady from Liberty, South Carolina knew exactly where he was buried and took us to the spot. He rest in the family lot. His mother and other members of his family are also there. His wife, Kate Archer Ariail, is buried in Atlanta, Georgia. Bottom picture is of the new stone for Thomas and the larger stone of other members of the family.
- 328. GraveStone328** – Top picture is of another stone in the family grave plot where Thomas Hamilton Boggs is interred. Bottom picture is the grave marker for Phineas Leonard Dunham who is interred with the Minnesota Regiment in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. Phineas Dunham, Union Army, and John Milton Ariail, Confederate Army, were cousins, fighting each other in Gettysburg. Both were wounded. Phineas died from his wounds but John Milton recovered and returned to Georgia after the war. Phineas is descended from Lucy Ariail and John Milton is descended from John Harvey Ariail, Sr. Those two were siblings.
- 329. GraveStone329** – Two more pictures of the cemetery where Phineas Leonard Dunham is interred.
- 330. GraveStone330** – Top picture is that of the family grave marker for Samuel O. Bacon and his wife Marie Louise Arial. Marie Louise Arial is the daughter of Michel Arial and Marie Louise Lemieux. Bottom picture is of the several graves that are contained within this family plot.
- 331. GraveStone331** – Top picture is more of the Bacon family graves in the Pine Hill Cemetery. We did not properly identify all these stones, but some of them may show up individually later. Bottom picture is of the marker for the family of Henry E. Arial. Henry is the son of Michel Arial and Marie Louise Lemieux. Henry is actually buried in the Elm Grove Cemetery, Greenfield, Massachusetts. His wife Exilda M. “Lizzie” Bushey and his son Henry E. Arial, Jr., are interred with this stone.
- 332. GraveStone332** – Top picture is the marker for George Fred Arial, son of Henry E. Arial. Bottom picture is marker for Charles William Arial and his wife Lena R. Bennett. Charles is the son of Henry E. Arial.
- 333. GraveStone333** – Top picture is for the marker of Mildred L. Johnson, wife of Walter Henry Arial. Bottom picture is a view of the resting place for Manna Rich Ariail in New Orleans, Louisiana. Manna Rich Ariail is the son of Luke Ariail of Connecticut. The Ariail Cemetery Committee assisted in restoring this grave site along with one of his descendants, John Ariail from Louisiana.
- 334. GraveStone334** – Two more pictures of the tomb of Manna Rich Ariail. His name was not on the tomb and the Ariail Cemetery Committee, as part of the restoration project, had his name carved on the door of the Tomb. The door was about to fall inside, the caulking of seams had fallen out, cracks in the stone covering and walls. The tomb was in bad shape when found by the Ariail Cemetery Committee.

- 335. GraveStone335** – Two more views of the tomb of Manna Rich Ariail. This tomb has “Tomb of Joseph Foy” carved on its door. The managers of this cemetery went into their vault and found records showing that when Manna Rich Ariail died, his remains were put in this Tomb. Manna Rich Ariail must have had some family relations or dealings with this man. Joseph Foy was from the Midwest. We believe the remains of the mother-in-law of Manna Rich Ariail are also interred in this tomb.
- 336. GraveStone336** – Top picture is another view of the Tomb of Manna Rich Ariail. Bottom marker is that for Lt. George Chester Kimball, a cousin of Lorraine Anne Patterson, wife of the Ariail Family Historian, James W. Patterson. He was born about 1803 in Beech Woods, Pennsylvania. He later moved to Gonzales, Texas with his wife and family. He made hats for an occupation but was also head of the Texas Rangers at Gonzales, Texas. When the call for reinforcements came from the Alamo, he gathered all his Texas Rangers, approximately 32 in number went to the Alamo and fought alongside David Crockett and the others that were there. They all died in that battle.
- 337. GraveStone337** – Top picture is of the family grave marker for the Judd Family in Dalton, Georgia. Bottom marker is for Morton Ellis Judd. Morton was the son of Hubert Lewellyn Judd from Connecticut. The Judd family were industrialists with manufacturing plants in Connecticut, New York and Chattanooga, Tennessee. Their products had a world-wide distribution. See other books of this web site for more extensive documentation of this family. Morton married his cousin, Lenna Gertrude Clarke. Family lore has it that the family rode their bicycles from Connecticut and when passing through Dalton, Georgia, Lenna told her husband to buy the piece of land on which they were resting and build her a home there. The Judd mansion still stands in Dalton today, along with the Carriage House which accompanies the home. Lenna’s yard is patterned after oriental gardens. Lenna was so well known that the faces of people in Dalton light up when her name is mentioned. A plaque to her memory was erected in the Georgia Botanical Gardens in Athens, Georgia.
- 338. GraveStone338** – Top picture is marker for Lenna Gertrude E. Judd, daughter of Ens. Morton Hubert Judd. Bottom picture is marker for Lenna Gertrude Clarke, wife of Morton Ellis Judd, who were both descendants of Lucy Ariail from Connecticut.
- 339. GraveStone339** – Top picture of marker for Ens. Morton Hubert Judd, son of Morton Ellis Judd and husband of Esther Katheryn Jones. Bottom picture is marker of Esther Katheryn Jones, wife of Ens. Morton Hubert Judd.
- 340. GraveStone340** – Top picture is marker for Lenna Gertrude Clarke, wife of Morton Ellis Judd. Bottom picture is marker for Woodrow Wilson “Jack” Coffee, son of Dora Letitia Ariail.
- 341. GraveStone341** – Top picture is marker for James Ernest Reid, II., a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail and her husband James Madison Reid. After Sarah Jane Ariail died young, her husband remarried and moved to Dublin, Texas. Bottom picture is marker for John Bennett Reid, a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 342. GraveStone342** – Top picture is for the marker of John M. Gillespie and his wife Lelia H. “Gip” Hopkins. John is the son of Mary Climelia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for James Franklin Echols and his wife Sylvia Boling. Sylvia is the daughter of Georgie Correnna Ariail.
- 343. GraveStone343** – Top picture is of the marker for James Ernest Reid, a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. His wife Olive Jones is buried in South Carolina. Bottom picture is marker for John Bennett Reid, Jr., son of John Bennett Reid and a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 344. GraveStone344** – Top picture is of marker for Ernestine G. Reid, daughter of James Ernest Reid, Jr., and a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. She is probably buried with her infant. See other sections of this web site for details on this tragic death. Bottom marker is of the stone for Ruby Mae Reid, daughter of James Ernest Reid, Jr., and a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 345. GraveStone345** – Left picture is marker for James Madison Reid, husband of Sarah Jane Ariail. Sarah Jane Ariail was the daughter of the Rev. John Harvey Ariail, Jr. Right picture is marker for William Thomas Reid, son of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 346. GraveStone346** – Top picture is marker for William Murray Reid, son of James Ernest Reid, Jr., and a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for John H. Reid, son of Sarah Jane Ariail. He was married to Azalea Ann Griffin but do not believe she went to Texas with him. To the best of our

efforts, we believe she stayed in South Carolina and is buried at the Beaverdam Baptist Church in Fair Play, South Carolina.

- 347. GraveStone347** – Top picture is another view of the family stone for William Thomas Reid. Bottom picture is marker for Mamie S., wife of Grover Gay Reid. Grover was a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 348. GraveStone348** – Top picture is marker for Grover Gay Reid, son of Stephen C. Reid and a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. Grover died in 1965 in De Leon, Texas. Bottom picture is marker for Ethel R. Robertson, 2nd wife of Grover Gay Reid.
- 349. GraveStone349** – Top picture is marker for Edgar Palma Reid and his wife Maggie Stringfellow. Not sure how this line ties into the family of James Madison Reid. Bottom picture is of the marker of Essie Reid, daughter of Stephen C. Reid the son of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 350. GraveStone350** – Left picture is marker for Eliza C. Stypes, wife of Stephen C. Reid. Right picture is marker for Stephen C. Reid, son of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 351. GraveStone351** – Left picture is marker for Elmer Reid, son of Stephen C. Reid from the Sarah Jane Ariail line. Right picture is of new marker for the military stone for Harvey Orlando Ariail, son of Luke Ives Ariail. There is a long story behind this individual some of which I will relate here. He was a Civil War Veteran and married to a woman named Hulah C. The family story goes that he was discharged from the army in Richmond and disappeared on his way home. After extensive research, it was found that he in fact died in the hospital at Richmond. Then it was the matter of where he was interred. In working with the people who are in charge of the Hollywood Cemetery in Richmond, it was found that he was interred under the wrong name. The Ariail Cemetery Committee then requested a new military marker for him, and the picture you see is that marker. Harvey can now rest in peace knowing that his relatives know where he is interred. Harvey left no children and what happened to his wife Hulah is not known.
- 352. GraveStone352** – Top picture is the marker for Lt. Col. Otto Henry Schumacher, II and his wife Rose Craig. Rose is a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. Bio: The US entered the WW-II European conflict in January 1942. Several months later, the Douglas A-26 Invader, an attack aircraft made its first flight on July 10, 1942. Production delivery began in August 1943 and on November 19, 1944 it went into combat over Europe. The WW-II victory in Europe (VE Day) occurred on May 8, 1945. After the war, Col Joseph R "Randy" Holzapple, Commander of the 319th Bombardment Group wanted to mark his place in history before the dissolution of the wartime Army Air Forces. He obtained Pentagon permission to demonstrate the capabilities of the Douglas A-26 Invader on a flight round-the-world. He selected Lt Col Charles R Meyers as his co-pilot and Lt Otto H Schumacher as navigator. Corporal Howard J Walden joined the crew as radio operator. On November 25, 1945 they departed Savannah GA heading westward on their flight round-the-world. Four days later they returned to Washington DC having successfully circumnavigated the earth. They demonstrated to the world that US light bombers could be dispatched to any point in the world on quick notice. In 1948 the USAF eliminated the attack aircraft category and re-designated the A-26 Invader as the B-26 Marauder, a medium bomber. Bottom picture is of the marker for Rose Craig, granddaughter of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 353. GraveStone353** – Left picture is the marker for Joan Fallon Craig, a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. Right picture is marker for James Edison Craig, a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 354. GraveStone354** – Left picture is of marker for Leone Hollister, wife of James Edison Craig. Right picture is marker for Lt. Col. Otto Henry Schumacher and his family.
- 355. GraveStone355** – Top picture are the grave markers for William D. Wiley, husband of Mary Climelia Ariail and the son Thomas B. Wiley. Bottom picture is marker for Thomas B. Wiley, son of Mary Climelia Ariail. This is another grave plot that was beautifully restored by the Ariail Cemetery Committee.
- 356. GraveStone356** – This is still another grave plot that was beautifully restored by the Ariail Cemetery Committee. These are the graves of Little Son Ariail and Aubrey Ariail, sons of James Claude Ariail and his wife Vastie Bellamy.
- 357. GraveStone357** – Both pictures are of the Ariail Cemetery Committee project to upgrade the graves of the two sons of James Claude Ariail.

- 358. GraveStone358** – Top picture is construction on upgrading the graves of the two sons of James Claude Ariail. Bottom picture is construction on upgrade of graves for William D. Wiley and his son, husband and son of Mary Climelia Ariail.
- 359. GraveStone359** – Top picture is the family marker for the Judd family in Wallingford, Connecticut. These are the descendants of Lucy Ariail. The bottom marker is another Judd family marker for the descendants of Lucy Ariail. See Cemetery Survey for all those buried in this cemetery in Wallingford, Connecticut.
- 360. GraveStone360** – Picture is the marker for Robert Francis “Bobby” Kinard, son of Moida Lucile “Dearie” Ariail. He was resting in an unmarked grave in Florence, South Carolina. The Ariail Cemetery Committee funded the placement of this marker on his grave. This grave now has perpetual care.
- 361. GraveStone361** – Top picture is grave stone for Ivan Paul Booher and his wife Naomi Lucille Coffin. Naomi is a descendant of Lucy Ariail from Connecticut. Bottom picture is Theoren Carter Chapman and his wife Donna Lou Coffin. Donna is a descendant of Lucy Ariail.
- 362. GraveStone362** – Top picture is the grave stone for John Morton Coffin and his 2nd wife Grace Belle Penney. John is a descendant of Lucy Ariail from Connecticut. Bottom picture is the stone for Franklin Parke Anderson and his wife Ruth Elizabeth Coffin. Ruth is a descendant of Lucy Ariail.
- 363. GraveStone363** – Top picture is marker for infant son of Kenneth Boyd Coffin and his wife Pauline B. Nickell. Bottom picture is stone for Kenneth B. Coffin and his wife Pauline B. Nickell. Kenneth is a descendant of Lucy Ariail from Connecticut.
- 364. GraveStone364** – Top picture is of a corn field in Annapolis, Indiana. A cemetery which we did not visit was the Coffin Cemetery. It is located in the plot of trees just back of the cornfield. Bottom picture is the marker for Sylvia Cowles, wife of Albert Dunham. Bio: Albert Dunham, son of Lucy Ariail, died in northeast North Carolina, probably on his way to or from visiting his relatives in South Carolina. A memorial stone is in the cemetery in Connecticut in his memory. After his death, his wife and children moved to Minnesota and she lived the remainder of her life there. Their son, Phineas Leonard Dunham, died in the Civil War. A picture of him is in the Ariail Family Photo section of the web site.
- 365. GraveStone365** – The top and bottom pictures are the only two large family markers for the Dunham family in Faribault, Minnesota. It is suspected that there may be some unmarked graves, but not sure. See Cemetery Survey Document in this web site for all those interred in the Oak Ridge Cemetery.
- 366. GraveStone366** – Top picture is marker for John Herman Thole, husband of Anastacia “Daisy” Dunham. Anastacia Dunham is a descendant of Lucy Ariail from Connecticut. Bottom picture is marker for Elinar John Bodine, 2nd husband of Anastacia “Daisy” Dunham.
- 367. GraveStone367** – Top picture is family marker for William H. Schmagel (listed as Schmakel on stone) and his wife Adah W. Dunham. Adah is a descendant of Lucy Ariail from Connecticut. Bottom picture is marker for Frederick “Fred” L. Dunham, a descendant of Lucy Ariail from Connecticut.
- 368. GraveStone368** – Top picture is a metal marker for Maude Marie Hinton, daughter of Samuel Duncan “Dunt” Hinton from the line of Climelia Abigail Ariail from South Carolina. She was born 20 Apr 1918, Farmersville, Texas and died 2 Jan 1957 in Harris County, Texas. Buried with other members of the family in the Nevada Cemetery, Nevada, Texas. Bottom picture is marker for William F. Rubush and his wife Catherine Lynn Chapman. Catherine is a descendant of Lucy Ariail from Connecticut.
- 369. GraveStone369** – Top picture is marker for Edward Beecher Chatfield, Sr., in Mt. View Cemetery, Rapid City, South Dakota. Edward is a descendant from Lucy Ariail of Connecticut. Bio. Edward lost his wife in 1902 and was left with a son and three daughters. He was afflicted with TB and was having a difficult time caring for his family. I am not sure if he was living in Dubuque, Iowa or Topeka, Kansas. I believe it to be Topeka, however, he sent a letter to his sister, Anna Augusta “Gussie” Chatfield Woods in Rapid City, South Dakota asking if they could come live with her so he would have some help since he was so sick. At first she refused him because she had 8 children of her own. I don’t know the lapse of time, but eventually she asked him to bring his family to South Dakota and be with them. Edward put his two 3 girls on a train and sent them ahead of him and his son. He then hitched up a team to a wagon and loaded his belongings and drove all the way to Rapid City, South Dakota. He died shortly thereafter and is interred with his sister in the cemetery there in Rapid City, South Dakota. Two members of the Ariail Cemetery Committee have met with Edward’s descendants and they are a gracious and wonderful people. Presently they own a 3,000 acre ranch

just outside Sundance, Wyoming. Bottom picture is marker for Alden H. Hinton and Jack W. Hinton, both sons of Samuel Duncan "Dunt" Hinton, descendants of Climelia Abigail Ariail.

- 370. GraveStone370** – Top picture is of the marker for Warren Joseph Forrest, son of Flora Delia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Vera Louise Forrest, wife of Robert Francis McCarthy and 2nd Leonard Curry Beckley. She was the daughter of Flora Delia Ariail.
- 371. GraveStone371** – Top picture is of the marker for Leonard Curry Beckley, husband of Vera Louise Forrest. Bottom picture is marker for Orin H. Gleason, step-father of Hannah Pixley, the wife of Stokes Smith Ariail.
- 372. GraveStone372** – Top picture is of the marker for Mary Jane Pixley Gleason, adoptive mother of Hannah Pixley who was the wife of Stokes Smith Ariail. Bottom picture is the family stone for the Gleason and Forrest family in Great Barrington, Massachusetts.
- 373. GraveStone373** – Top picture is of the grave markers for Abigail Manna Ariail and Flora Ariail, both daughters of Luke Ariail and his wife Abigail Prentice. The two graves were unmarked in the town cemetery in Stockbridge, Massachusetts. The Ariail Cemetery Committee located these graves and with the approval of the Ariail Reunion Association, placed the new markers on the graves. There is one other unmarked Ariail grave in this cemetery and that is of the remains of Manna Goodwin Ariail, son of Lt. Col. Manna Rich Ariail from Louisiana. We have recovered documentation that Manna Rich Ariail brought his son from Louisiana to Massachusetts in an attempt to save his life, and his son Manna Goodwin Ariail died there in Stockbridge. The exact grave plot is not known, but he is buried here in this cemetery. Bottom picture is that of Lorraine Anne Patterson at the head of the graves of the two Ariail girls on which the new stones were placed.
- 374. GraveStone374** – Left picture is the marker for Seth Hubbell Addis and his wife Mary Carolina Ariail. Mary is the daughter of John Prentice Ariail. Right picture is marker for Charles John Prentice Ariail, son of John Prentice Ariail.
- 375. GraveStone375** – Left picture is the marker for Seth Henry Prindle Addis, son of Mary Carolina Ariail. Right picture is marker for Charles A. Addis, son of Mary Carolina Ariail.
- 376. GraveStone376** – Left picture is marker for Samuel West Addis, son of Mary Caroline Ariail. Right picture is marker for Caroline Prindle, wife of John Prentice Ariail. John was the son of Luke Ariail, brother of Esq. Ens. John Harvey Ariail, Sr., who came to South Carolina in 1795.
- 377. GraveStone377** – Left picture is marker for Henry Ariail Dunham, son of Lucy Ariail. Right picture is the grave marker for Edward Howard Dunham and Mary C. Dunham, both children of Henry Ariail Dunham.
- 378. GraveStone378** – Left picture is marker (perhaps memorial) for Albert Dunham, husband of Sylvia Cowles and son of Lucy Ariail. He died in Currituck County, North Carolina, probably going to or from visiting his relatives in South Carolina. There are two blank spaces next to his grave stone which may contain the remains of his two children, Sarah and Martha Maria Dunham. Right picture is marker for Irma Kimball Wilson, a cousin of Lorraine Anne Kimball Patterson.
- 379. GraveStone379** – Left picture is family marker for the Dea. Morton L. Judd and his wife Lucina Dunham. Lucina is the daughter of Lucy Ariail. Right picture is that of the family members of Lorraine Anne Kimball Patterson and her family at the committal service for her mother at the cemetery in Milo, Maine.
- 380. GraveStone380** – Top picture is marker of Lucina Dunham, wife of Dea. Morton L. Judd and daughter of Lucy Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Dea. Morton L. Judd, husband of Lucina Dunham. Morton Judd founded the Judd Company in Wallingford, Connecticut. That Company is now known as the Stanley Company. For further bio on this individual, see various documents in the Ariail Family Web site.
- 381. GraveStone381** – Top picture is marker for Julia Ann Blinn, 2nd wife of Dea. Morton L. Judd. Bottom picture is marker for Mary Burnham "Minnie" Judd, daughter of Dea. Morton L. Judd.
- 382. GraveStone382** – Left picture is grave marker for William Theodore "Willie" Judd, son of Judge Edward Morton Judd. Right picture is grave stone for Judge Edward Morton Judd and his wife Jane A. Peck. Judge Judd is the grandson of Lucy Ariail.
- 383. GraveStone383** – Top picture is grave marker for Elmer Goudelock Littlejohn and his wife Frances Kathleen Ariail. Frances Kathleen Ariail is the daughter of the Rev. William Hamilton Ariail. Bottom picture is graver marker for Herbert G. Mann and his wife Loeta Barr. Loeta is great grandniece of Mary Adelaide Barr who was the wife of William Harrison Ariail.

- 384. GraveStone384** – Top picture is grave marker for James Heyward Styron and his wife Rosie Smith. James is the son of Lillie Beatrice Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Catherine “Kate” Barr wife of Clarence M. “Pete” Entrekin. Catherine is great grandniece of Mary Adelaide Barr, wife of William Harrison Ariail.
- 385. GraveStone385** – Top picture is grave marker for Jennie Ariail, wife of Leonard Hamilton Martin. Bottom picture is marker for William Harold “Dandy” McLees, Sr., and his wife Nancy Craig. Nancy is a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail.
- 386. GraveStone386** – Top picture is grave stone for Robert Alexander Craig and his wife Nina Elizabeth Sutherland. Nina is a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for Roy Carlisle Taylor and his wife Sarah Grace Craig. Sarah is a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. See Cemetery Survey for vitals on Sarah Grace Craig.
- 387. GraveStone387** – Top picture is grave stone for Charles Robert Craig and his wife Minnie Lou Reese. Charles is a descendant of Sarah Jane Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Catherine Wilson, wife of John Nean Craig. She was the grandmother of Martha Craig, wife of John Harvey Ariail, III, who died in the Civil War.
- 388. GraveStone388** – Top picture is marker for Jane Dent Bruton, wife of Charles Wellington Wyatt and daughter of Ellen Wells Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Ellen Wells Ariail, wife of John Thompson Bruton and daughter of Julius Fellows Ariail, I.
- 389. GraveStone389** – Top picture is of marker for John Thompson Bruton, husband of Ellen Wells Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Ellen Ariail Bruton, wife of Dr. John Philip Fischer. Ellen is the daughter of Ellen Wells Ariail.
- 390. GraveStone390** – Top picture is marker for Manna Rich Ariail, son of Jean-Baptiste (John) Ariail and Hannah Rich. Bottom picture is marker for Elizabeth Bulick his wife. When the Ariail Cemetery Committee found these two graves they were listed as abandoned. The graves are at St. Michael’s Cemetery in St. Martinsville, Louisiana. They were to be cleaned off and the plot sold to someone else to be used. Through extensive negotiations with the personnel in charge of the cemetery, the Ariail Cemetery Committee purchased perpetual rights to these two graves. There is a deed in the Ariail Library to that effect and the graves are not to be destroyed or reused by anyone in the future. This is the brother of John Harvey Ariail, Sr. who married Climelia Chloe Ives and lived in South Carolina.
- 391. GraveStone391** – Top picture is a panoramic view of the Cyprus Grove Cemetery #1 where Lt. Col. Manna Rich Ariail is interred. He was the son of Luke Ariail from Connecticut. Bottom picture is marker for Catherine Denise Eddy, wife of the Rev. John Michael Ariail.
- 392. GraveStone392** – Top picture is marker for Emma Margaret Ziebell, wife of Ralph Edmund Ariail, Sr. Bottom picture is marker for Ralph Edmund Ariail, Sr., son of John Alvin Ariail.
- 393. GraveStone393** – Top picture is panoramic view of Bethania Cemetery in Justice, Illinois where Ralph Edmund Ariail and his family are interred. Bottom picture is marker for Infant Grier, child of Julia Zenobia Barr, Great grandnephew of Mary Adelaide Barr who was married to William Harrison Ariail.
- 394. GraveStone394** – Top picture is historical marker in front of the Pickens Chapel. Bottom picture is of the Pickens Chapel where John and Chloe Ives Ariail attended church. They are interred in the woods behind the chapel in what is known as the Pickens Chapel Cemetery in Anderson County, South Carolina.
- 395. GraveStone395** – Top picture is marker for Jeannette Dent Blackman, wife of Julius Fellows Ariail, I. Bottom marker is for Julius Fellows Ariail, I., son of Manna Rich Ariail. His remains were removed from another Cemetery. See other pictures in this document for other stone and cemetery for Julius.
- 396. GraveStone396** – Top picture is marker for Manna Rich Ariail, son of Julius Fellows Ariail, I. Bottom picture is marker for Marie Louise Murphy, wife of Julius Fellows Ariail, II.
- 397. GraveStone397** – Top picture is marker for Julius Fellows Ariail, II, son of Julius Fellows Ariail, I. Bottom picture is marker for Jeannette Ariail Petrie, daughter of Jeannette Dent Ariail and wife of Philip Aloysius Jacobs.
- 398. GraveStone398** – Top picture is grave stone for Victor Lawrence Ariail and his wife Mariah Elizabeth “Lizzie” Teague. There is quiet a story behind this member of our family. He was originally listed in the Ariail family tree as Victoria Ariail (female) and no one knew where the family member disappeared to. It took several years for the family historian to eventually get some clues that the family member was a male. Eventually we learned that he was somewhere in Louisiana. We made a trip to the northern part of Louisiana and

began to find documents as to who he had married. Then we could not find his grave. There was a good reason for this problem, look at how the tomb stone is inscribed. Evidently everyone knew him a "Uncle Vick". Although Ariail is carved on the tomb stone, it is carved as his first name, with the family name as "Vick". Again we find the family Historians finding information that led to discovering where one of the family members lived and died when even his closest living relatives did not know the information. Bottom picture is the beautiful Memorial Marker for the Craig Cemetery. There is a story behind the Craig cemetery. It seems that when the Nuclear Power Plant was being constructed in South Carolina, the lake that was developed for its cooling water, took the land which originally contained the Craig family graves sites. All these graves were removed and placed in another location so they would not be covered by the lake. As you can see, the Craig families descend from a proud heritage and the manner in which they maintain their cemetery reflects the pride they possess within the family.

403. [GraveStone403](#) – Top picture is marker for Louise Cheeseborough Walton, wife of Harry Ariail Boggs. Bottom marker is for Frederick Schlucter George, 2nd husband of Louise Cheeseborough Walton.
404. [GraveStone404](#) – Left picture is marker for John Geoffrey Wood, husband of Marie Ariail Boggs. Right picture is marker for Marie Ariail Boggs, granddaughter of Kate Archer Ariail.
405. [GraveStone405](#) – Left marker is for Clarence Ariail Foster. Don't know who he was, probably named after The Rev. James Warren Ariail. Right marker is for the grave of Donald Franklin Bowles, husband of Marie Ariail Boggs who was a descendant of Kate Archer Ariail.
406. [GraveStone406](#) – Left picture is marker for Karl B. Ariail, son of the Rev. James Warren Ariail. Right picture is marker for L. Armond Ariail, son of the Rev. James Warren Ariail who was the son of Luke Ives Ariail.
407. [GraveStone407](#) – The two pictures in this frame are of a baby of R. R. & M. E. Dagewitt. The grave is located in the family plot of the Rev. James Warren Ariail where he buried his two children. Don't know who it is.
408. [GraveStone408](#) – The top picture is marker for William Hobart Rhinehart and his wife Ila Marie Epton. Ila is the daughter of Nancy Pearl Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for James Ansel Epton, grandson of Nancy Pearl Ariail.
409. [GraveStone409](#) – Top picture is marker for Paul Conley Brannon and his wife Elizabeth Allen. Elizabeth Allen was thrice married with her 2nd husband being Martin Ansel Epton to which she bore a son. Bottom picture is marker for Anne Elizabeth Epton. Relationship to family unknown.
410. [GraveStone410](#) – Top picture is marker for Lois Finley, wife of Joel R. Griffin. Lois is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Jean Griffin Wofford. Jean is a step descendant of Lucinda Parthenia Ariail.

415. **GraveStone415** – Top picture is the Boggs family grave plot. The green plot at the far end of the family lot is the place where the Ariail Cemetery Committee placed a new marker on the unmarked grave of Thomas Hamilton Boggs, son of George W. Barzelai Boggs and husband of Kate Archer Ariail. Thomas was also the brother of Hon. Julius Elkanah Boggs of Greenville, South Carolina. Bottom picture is marker for Thilitha A. Mullinnix, 1st wife of Albert Harrison Ariail. The Ariail Cemetery Committee restored this stone by cleaning and shoring up the base of the stone so it’s integrity would be maintained.
416. **GraveStone416** – Top picture is marker for Mary Beatrice Batson, 1st wife of Rev. Willie Cureton Richey who was a descendant of Climelia Abigail Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for the Rev. Willie Cureton Richey, a great grandson of Climelia Abigail Ariail.
417. **GraveStone417** – Top picture is family stone for Luther Cowan Richey and his wife Anna M. Cureton. Anna is a descendant of Climelia Abigail Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Abner H. Cureton Seay, son of Anne M. Cureton. He is great grandson of Climelia Abigail Ariail.
418. **GraveStone418** – Top picture is grave marker for Cecil Alva Nicholson and his wife Inez Barr. Inez is the great grandniece of Mary Adelaide Barr who was wife of William Harrison Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Donald Ray Boyce, husband of Betty Jane Styron. Betty is a descendant of Lillie Beatrice Ariail.
419. **GraveStone419** – Top picture is new stone for Narcissus Emaline Orr, wife of John Milton Barr. This stone was placed by descendants of the Barr family in coordination with the Ariail Cemetery Committee. You will note that John Milton Barr is a brother to Mary Adelaide Barr, wife of William Harrison Ariail. The John Milton Barr listed here as husband is nephew of Mary Adelaide Barr. Also of interest, Mary Adelaide Barr Ariail named one of her sons John Milton Ariail. As you can see, genealogy is a fascinating study of family history. Bottom picture is of the Nails Creek Baptist Church in Banks County Georgia where many of the Ariail family has attended since about 1854. The first person buried in the Cemetery was Lemuel Lawrence Ariail after he died from measles in the Civil War. The reason for choosing the Churchyard as a resting place for Lemeul Lawrence Ariail, it that it is said his father was afraid they would lose the farm because of the war and chose not to start a family cemetery on the farm.

422. **GraveStone422** – Top picture is the grave stone for Olive Jones, wife of James Ernest Reid, Jr., and their daughter Sarah Pauline Reid. James is buried in Texas. These are descendants of Sarah Jane Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Estelle H. Wilmot, wife of William J. “Bill” Boling who is son of Georgie Correnna Ariail.

The stones were all cleaned, coping put around the family lot, new markers for the unmarked graves of John Alvin Ariail and his 2nd wife Mary Ethel Brown, plastic and weed killer placed on the ground and chipped granite stone over the grave plot. Bottom picture is of the markers

- for James Hamilton Ariail and his daughter Nannie Leona Ariail. James is the son of John Alvin Ariail. These graves are in the John Alvin Ariail family lot that were upgraded by the Ariail Cemetery Committee.
426. **GraveStone426** – Top picture is of the almost completed restoration of the John Alvin Ariail Family lot. Bottom picture is the same lot at a different stage of restoration.
 427. **GraveStone427** – Top picture is markers for the graves of James Hamilton Ariail and his wife Mary L. “Minnie” Rhoden in the newly restored family plot of John Alvin Ariail. The large marker on right is for “Minnie” and the ground level marker on left is that for James Hamilton Ariail. The work was done by the Ariail Cemetery Committee. The bottom picture is for the markers of Lillie Beatrice Ariail and her son Nolan Veldee Styron. Lillie is the daughter of Lillie Beatrice Ariail. The work on this plot was done by the Ariail Cemetery Committee.
 428. **GraveStone428** – Top and bottom pictures show various stages of construction of the John Alvin Ariail family plot at Rose Hill Cemetery in Piedmont, South Carolina. This work was being accomplished by the Ariail Family Cemetery Committee.
 429. **GraveStone429** – Top picture show the John Alvin Ariail family lot again with construction almost completed. This work accomplished by Ariail Cemetery Committee. Bottom picture is marker for Woodrow Wilson “Jack” Coffee and his wife Lois Morene Garrison. Woodrow is the son of Dora Letitia Ariail.
 430. **GraveStone430** – Top picture is grave marker for Jacob Harold Meyer, husband of Amaryllis Hamilton Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for William J. “Bill” Boling, husband of Estelle H. Wilmot. William is the son of Georgie Correnna Ariail.
 431. **GraveStone431** – Top picture is grave marker for Henrietta I. Tucker, wife of Henry Ariail Dunham who is the son of Lucy Ariail. Bottom picture is grave marker for Lucy Ariail, daughter of Jean-Baptiste (John) Mathias Ariail and his 2nd wife Hannah Rich. Lucy Ariail was thrice married, bearing 8 children by her first husband.
 432. **GraveStone432** – Left picture is a panoramic view of the Bellamy Cemetery in Bethlehem, Connecticut. Luke Ariail and part of his family are interred here. Right picture is another view of the grave marker for Lucy Ariail with Lorraine Patterson standing by its side. The graves were somewhat grown up with bushes around the stone and we cleared them away while we were there.
 433. **GraveStone433** – Top picture is grave marker for John Murphy Ariail, son of Julius Fellows Ariail, II. Bottom picture is of the grave marker for Andrew Heath Petrie, husband of Jeannette Dent Ariail who was the daughter of Julius Fellows Ariail, I.
 434. **GraveStone434** – Top picture is the grave marker for Jeannette Dent Ariail, wife of Andrew Heath Petrie and daughter of Julius Fellows Ariail, I. Bottom picture is of the Manna Ariail and his wife Elizabeth Bulick. Manna is the son of Jean-Baptiste (John) Mathias Ariail and his wife Hannah Rich. There are other views of these two graves in this document. The Ariail Cemetery Committee purchased these two graves to keep them from being cleaned of stones and sold to someone else for their burial site. A copy of the deed is contained in the Ariail Library.
 435. **GraveStone435** – These are duplicate pictures of the tomb for Manna Rich Ariail, son of Luke Ariail in the Cyprus Grove Cemetery #1 in New Orleans, Louisiana. As you can readily see, the tomb is in pretty bad disrepair. The Ariail Cemetery Committee, along with John Ariail, a descendant of Manna Rich Ariail, took on the job of repairing this tomb. See Historical/Cemetery Committee annual reports for details. This is the tomb of Joseph Hoy, but he is not buried here. Manna Rich Ariail was married to Eliza Jones Bronaugh as his 1st marriage and a lady by the name of Julia Bowles is in the same tomb with Manna Rich Ariail. It is believed that Julia is somehow related to Manna, perhaps being his mother-in-law.
 436. **GraveStone436** – Top picture is grave marker for Ralph Edmund Ariail, Sr., and his wife Emma Margaret Ziebell. Ralph is the son of John Alvin Ariail. Bottom picture is of the marker for Richard W. and Minnie Ziebell, parents of Emma Margaret Ziebell, wife of Ralph Edmund Ariail, Sr.
 437. **GraveStone437** – Top picture is marker for Walker Martin Herman Cureton, husband of Willie Simpson Adams and a descendant of Climelia Abigail Ariail. Bottom picture is marker for Willis Simpson Adams, wife of Walker Martin Herman Cureton.
 438. **GraveStone438** – Left and right pictures are of the funeral grave site of Hubert Freeman Ariail. He was the son of James Claude Ariail and uncle of the Ariail Family Historian.

439. **GraveStone439** – Both top and bottom pictures and some following below are images of the grave restoration for Joseph Dallas Ariail. He was the son of Guy Otis Ariail and Elizabeth “Lizzie” Henderson. Bio: Joseph was thrice married. He disappeared in York County, South Carolina. When his body was found it appeared that he had been murdered. He was placed in a pauper’s grave in the Evergreen Cemetery, Chester, South Carolina. Many years later the Ariail Cemetery Committee found out about what had happened and where he was interred. The actual grave site was located by his brother and sister-in-law. Since none within the family had the funds to take action to mark his grave, the Ariail Cemetery Committee took on the project and now the grave has been marked.
440. **GraveStone440** – Two more picture of the Joseph Dallas Ariail grave site after new stone was placed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee.
441. **GraveStone441** – Top picture is an image of the family plot for James Claude Ariail and his wife Vastie Bellamy after the Ariail Cemetery Committee cleaned and put weed killer, new plastic and chipped stone on this grave. James Claude Ariail is the son of James Leland Ariail. Bottom picture is image of the family plot for Kermit Parks Ariail and his wife Allie Neoma Grizzle after the Ariail Cemetery Committee finished cleaning up his grave site the same as his father’s in top picture. Kermit Parks Ariail is the son of James Claude Ariail.
442. **GraveStone442** – The following pictures for several frames are a series of pictures of the Ariail Cemetery Committee’s work on the very large grave plot for James Leland Ariail and his descendants. See Historical/Cemetery Reports for further details on any of these restoration projects.
443. **GraveStone443** – Two more images of the same restoration project. Note the new double marker which is closest in the pictures that the Ariail Cemetery Committee placed for William Harrison Ariail and his wife Mary Adelaide Barr. The tall beautiful marker at the end of the picture is that for James Leland Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail. In later pictures of this same plot, look and see how beautifully the entire plot was restored.
444. **GraveStone444** – Top picture is of the tall stone for James Leland Ariail, son of William Harrison Ariail. After cleaning by the Ariail Cemetery Committee, the stone displays its beautiful different colors sitting in the restored grave plot. Bottom picture is of the entire grave plot after it was finished. The discolored stone near the coping is from being wet after washing the stone to removed dust.
445. **GraveStone445** – Top picture is of the new grave stone for William Harrison Ariail and his wife Mary Adelaide Barr after the Ariail Cemetery Committee placed the new stone and upgraded the entire family plot. You will not that we left the ancient stones which marked their graves in place. Bottom picture is another view of the entire lot.
446. **GraveStone446** – Both top and bottom pictures are of the restoration project performed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee on the unmarked graves for William Oscar Ariail and his wife Lenora C. Brown. William is the son of John Alvin Ariail. Apparently these family members had limited resources and a stone was never placed on their graves. The grave site was located by one of their descendants.
447. **GraveStone447** – These are two pictures of the very nice marker placed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee on the graves of William Oscar Ariail and his wife Lenora C. Brown.
448. **GraveStone448** – These two pictures are of the grave marker that the Ariail Cemetery Committee placed for Chloe Jane Hamilton, wife of Dr. Pascal Dacus Cureton. She was the daughter of Climelia Abigail Ariail and was buried in an unmarked grave in Easley, South Carolina.
449. **GraveStone449** – Another picture of the marker placed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee for Chloe Jane Hamilton. Bottom picture is of marker placed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee for John Alvin Ariail, son of Luke Ives Ariail.
450. **GraveStone450** – Top picture is marker placed by the Ariail Cemetery Committee for Mary Ethel Brown, 2nd wife of John Alvin Ariail. Bottom picture is of Lorraine Patterson relaxing with her “ever ready” book at a Motel in Ringgold, Georgia while we were showing our cousins, Karine, Fabrice and Anne Ariail and Cedric Emonides around Chattanooga, Tennessee, while they were visiting from France.
